# **BUILDING CODE**

Insert between pages 712d and 713 of your bound volume of the NYC Building Code.

Add new sections 3319.12, 3319.12.1 and 3319.12.2 to read as follows:

**3319.12 Crane event recorder.** No certificate of operation for a crane shall be issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2019, unless the crane is equipped with an event recorder that is supplied by the crane manufacturer, or by a dealer, distributor, vendor, or third-party authorized crane manufacturer.

**Exception:** Cranes where the manufacturer certifies to the department that an event recorder cannot be installed on the crane due to a technological limitation.

<u>3319.12.1 Data to be recorded.</u> At a minimum, the event recorder shall collect the following data:

- 1. Crane configuration;
- 2. Any overload condition;
- 3. Status of limit switches; and
- 4. Operator overrides.

<u>3319.12.2 Data to be made available to commissioner upon request.</u> Data collected by the event recorder shall be made available to the commissioner upon request.
