RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the construction of a greenway and daylighting of Tibbetts Brook, between West 230th Street and Hester and Piero's Mill Pond, Van Cortlandt Park, Bronx, submitted by the Department of Environmental Protection and the Department of Parks & Recreation, represented by exhibits 1960-EB, EC, ED, EE, EF, EG & EH of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that prior to returning for final review, the team will (1) holistically refine the architectural elements along the greenway to make the space feel recognizable as a truly public, pedestrianized space, including by (a) reconsidering the suitability of the Davit pole for a pedestrian and cycling path, (b) considering the cohesion, detailing, and transparency of the railing design, decking, and gates across all different site widths and landscape types, particularly where the path is narrow and the railing could feel heavy, opaque, or constricting, and (c) thinking about the architectural identity and detailing along the length of the corridor and how it varies based on the width and context of the site; (2) update the presentation to provide (a) detailed cross sections showing the ways in which the structures, railings, lighting, furnishings, planting, and other elements relate to the varied site conditions along each segment of the project and (b) a phasing and construction sequencing diagram; (3) develop a signage strategy and graphic that pulls the design together across all of the landscape types and that (a) considers the experience of pedestrians accessing the greenway at different entry points and (b) relates to the NYC Parks graphic identity standards while also distinguishing itself as a unique greenway space; and (4) clarify the maintenance strategy further, including (a) whether the porous pavement will be regularly vacuumed, (b) whether a replanting budget can be reserved for the future, and (c) whether the design team can help NYC Parks and DEP to establish a maintenance guide for the site.
