RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the installation of an interpretive signage system, 34th Street Partnership, Tenth Avenue, 30th Street, Park Avenue and 36th Street, Manhattan, submitted by the Department of Transportation, represented by exhibits 6276-AJ, AK, AL & AM of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval to Version A with "Know NYC" with the understanding that (1) the designer will consider (a) eliminating the black border at the top by extending the color to the edges, (b) using a white background with black type instead of a black background with color type, and (c) eliminating the BID attribution on one side of the panel; (2) the edits provided by the Commission will be incorporated into the first three signs; (3) the final layout, text and location for the remaining 18 signs will be submitted for committee review prior to developing final drawings; and (4) the final design will serve as a prototype for use throughout the City.
