

Overdose Deaths Among Manhattan Residents, 2021



Manhattan residents ages 55 to 84 had the largest number of overdose deaths.




Latino/a Manhattan residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.




32.8 residents per 100,000 died of a drug overdose.


Manhattan residents had the third highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).




Manhattan residents ages 55 to 84 had the highest rate of overdose death.
