


Queens residents died of a drug overdose.

Queens residents had the second lowest number of overdose deaths.




21.4 residents per 100,000 died of a drug overdose.


Queens residents had the lowest rate of overdose death.




Queens residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.




Queens residents ages 35 to 54 had the highest rate of overdose death.




White Queens residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
