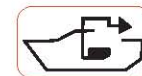

**NO DISCHARGE AREAS. (NDA)** The Hudson River has been declared a No Discharge Area by the U.S. EPA. It is illegal to discharge untreated sewage from your holding tank or portable toilet or use a direct discharge toilet anywhere in the Hudson River or Long Island Sound or in any of NYS inland waters. Boaters may only discharge untreated sewage three miles beyond the U.S. territorial limit. Unless the water body is designated as a NDA, boaters can discharge treated sewage from a Type I or Type II USCG certified Marine Sanitation Device. However, this practice is discouraged in all waters of New York Harbor and near shore water and areas of high boat concentrations.
