



- Has a community petition with over 330 signatures



Proposed Improvements


Improve Safety at Atlantic Ave with Shorter Crosswalks by:









3. Washington Possible Striping Plan




One moving lane with turn bays as needed for reduced vehicle weaving

Proposed Improvements

- 1. Improve Safety at Atlantic Ave with Shorter Crosswalks by:
 - Expanding Lowry Triangle Park and Greenstreets Island
 - Add neckdowns where feasible
 - Restrict eastbound left turns from Atlantic to Washington and replace turn bay with Treed Median
 - Extend Median in East crosswalk
- 2. At Grand Ave and Park Place:
 - Add Crosswalk Refuge
 - Construct Island in South crosswalk
- 3. Restripe corridor with clear travel lanes, adding possible striped bicycle lanes
