






Division St Current Condition




Division St Plan

Division St Cross Section




Bowery at Division St




Double parking in third lane on northbound Bowery creates weaving traffic patterns

Project Benefits

- Adds ~2,900 square feet of pedestrian space
- Provides waiting area for commuter van passengers and relieves sidewalk congestion
- Maintains moving lanes and minimally impacts parking
- Limits excess space for double and triple parking
- Calms and rationalizes traffic
- Improves accessibility
- Prevents merging congestion on Bowery
