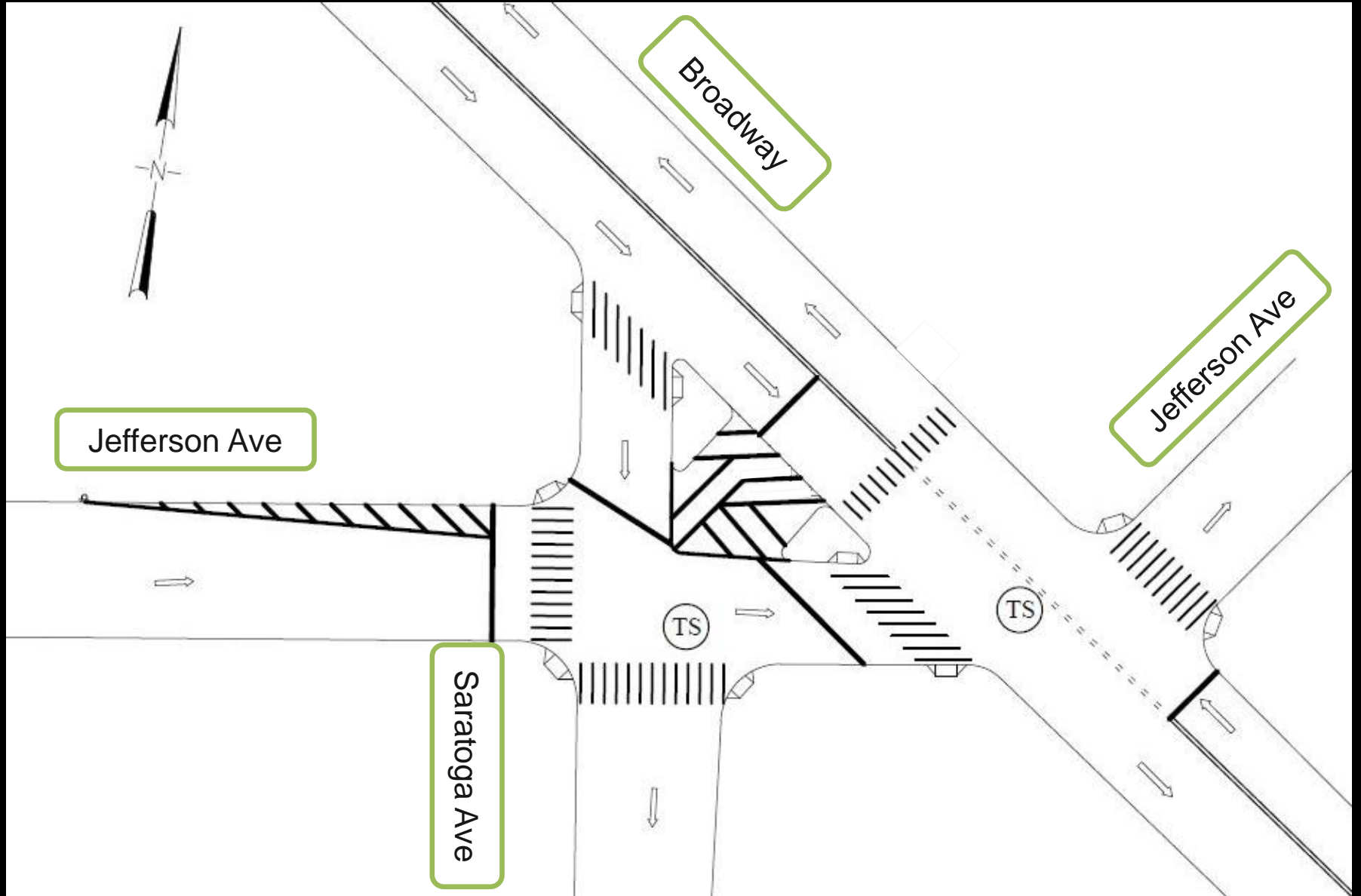

# Existing Issues

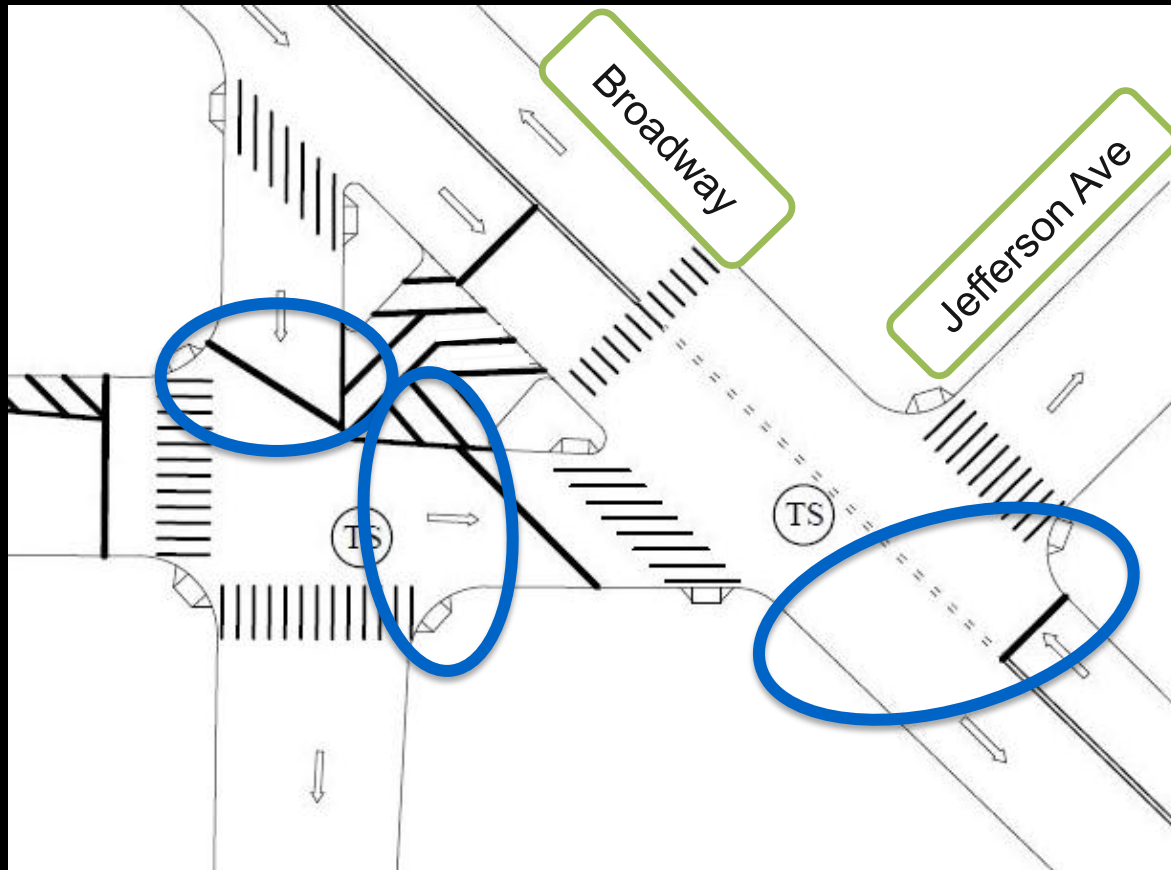


## Issues:

Channelized area between two small islands creates confusing and unattractive environment for pedestrians

Existing crosswalk has no pedestrian ramps and leads into subway support pole

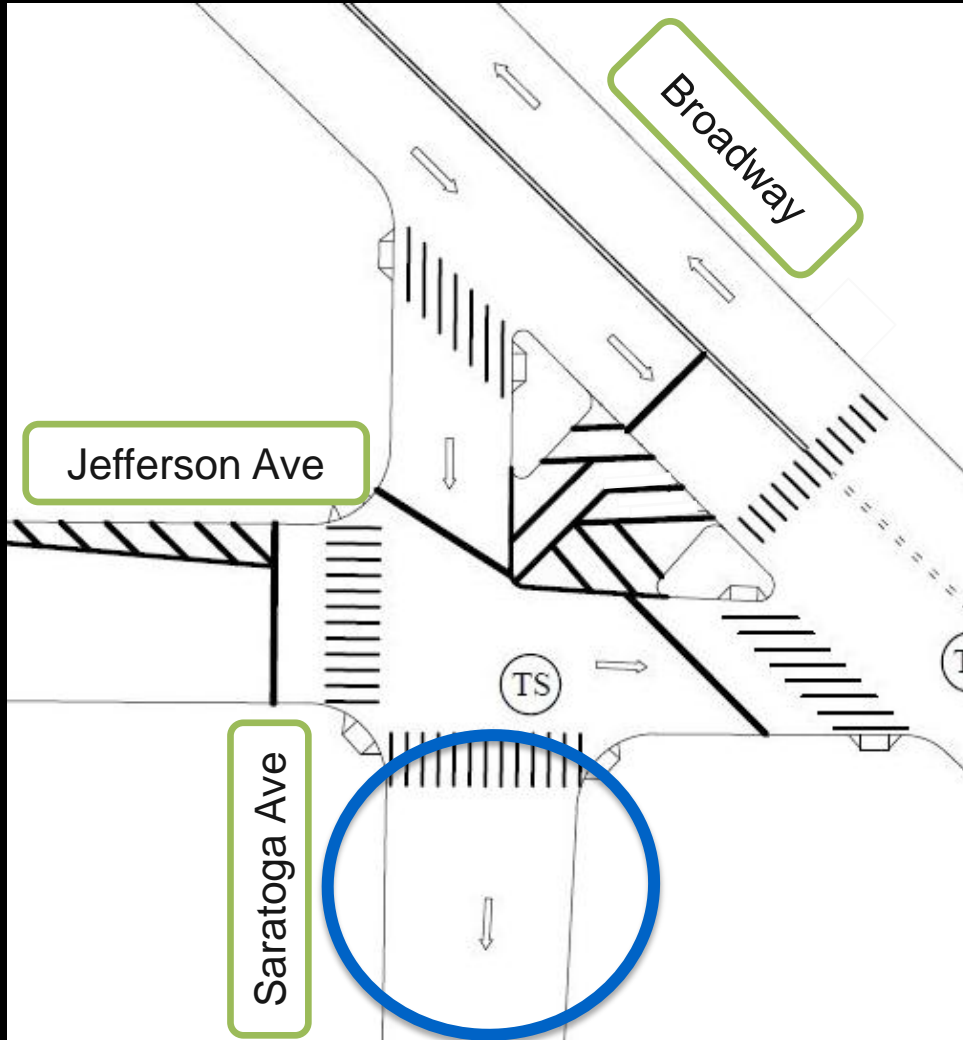
# Existing Issues

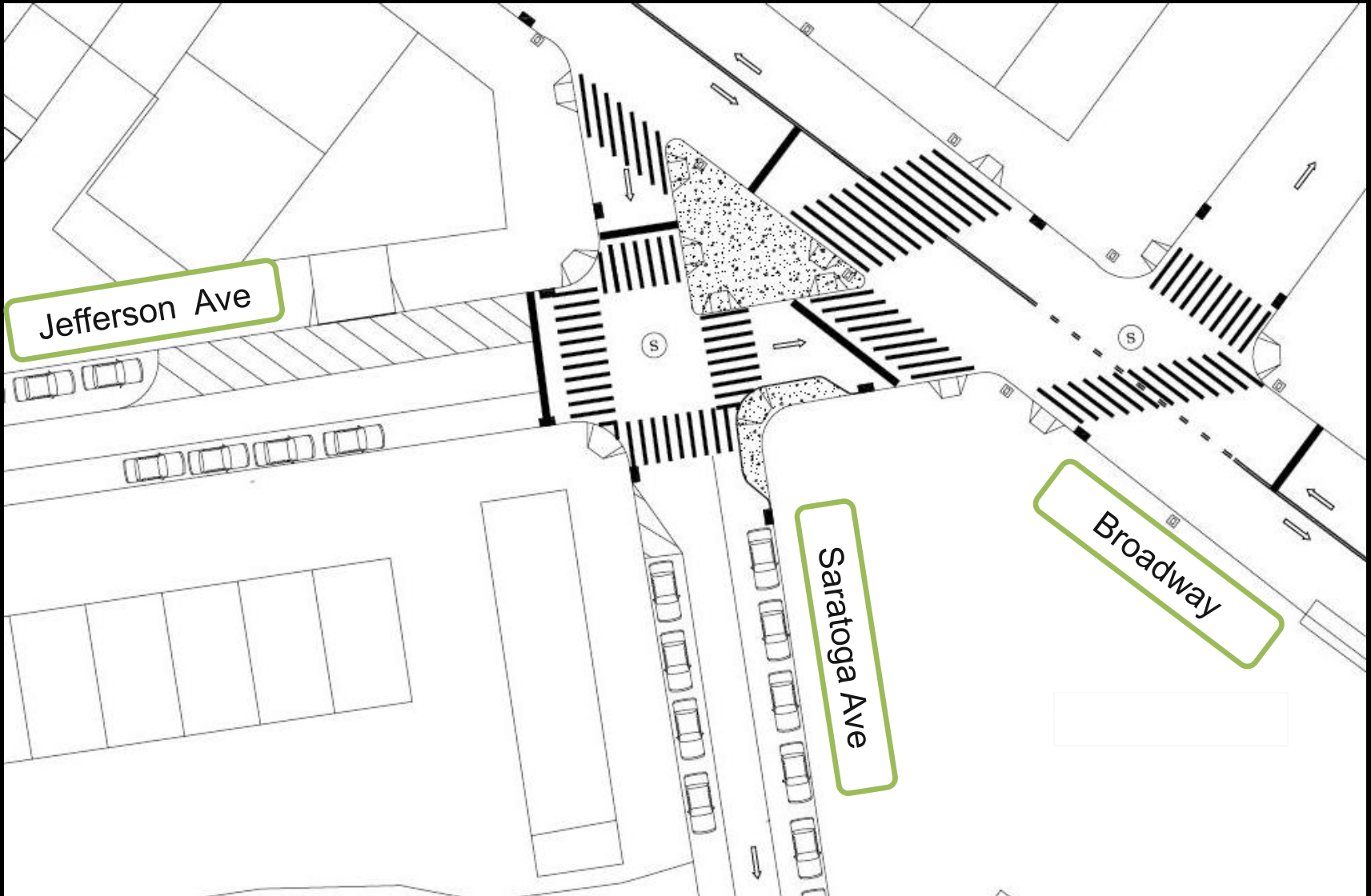
## Issues:

2 substandard moving lanes on Saratoga Avenue (19')

(Vision Zero Priority Corridor)

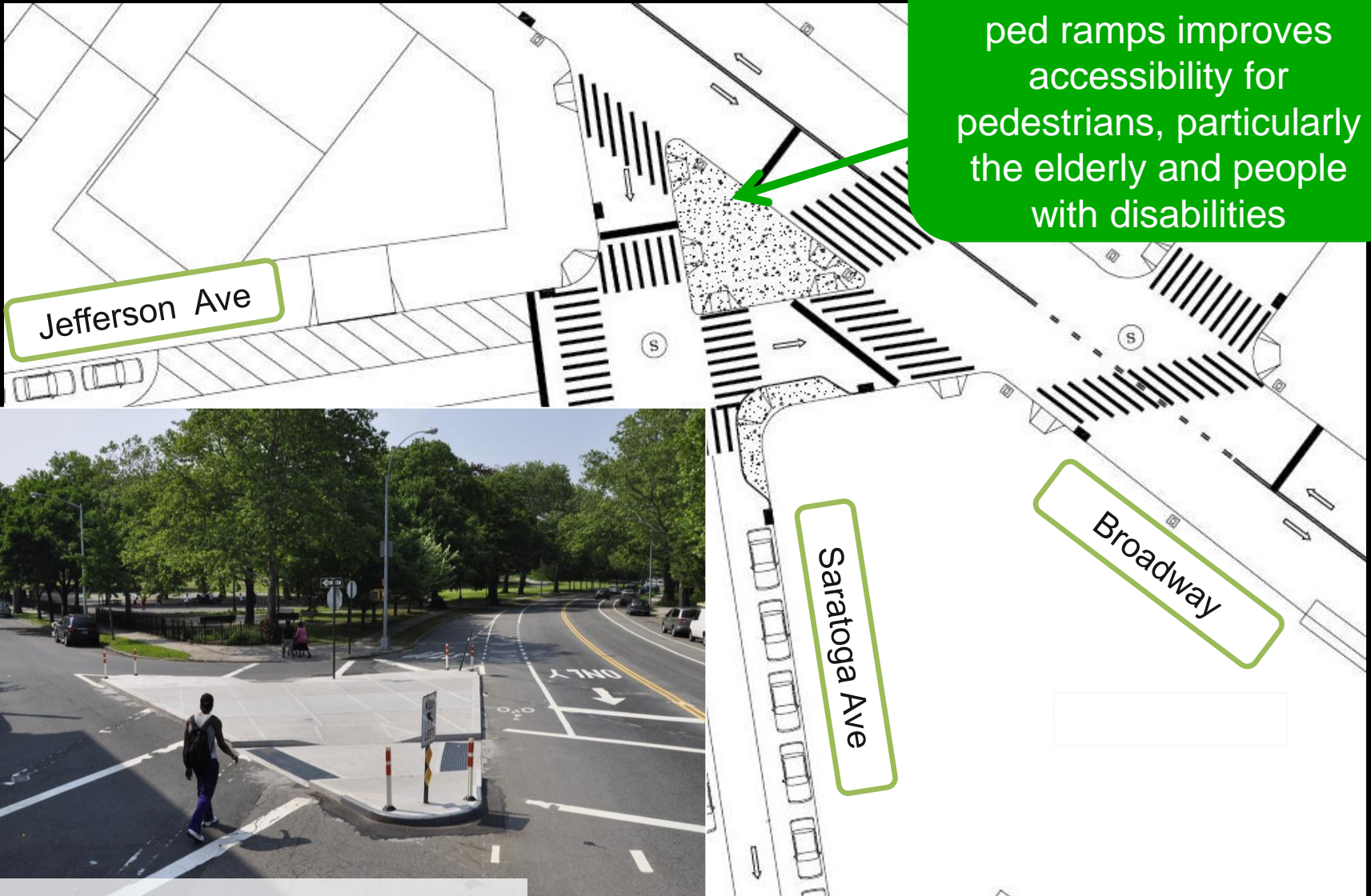

# 1. Pedestrian Space

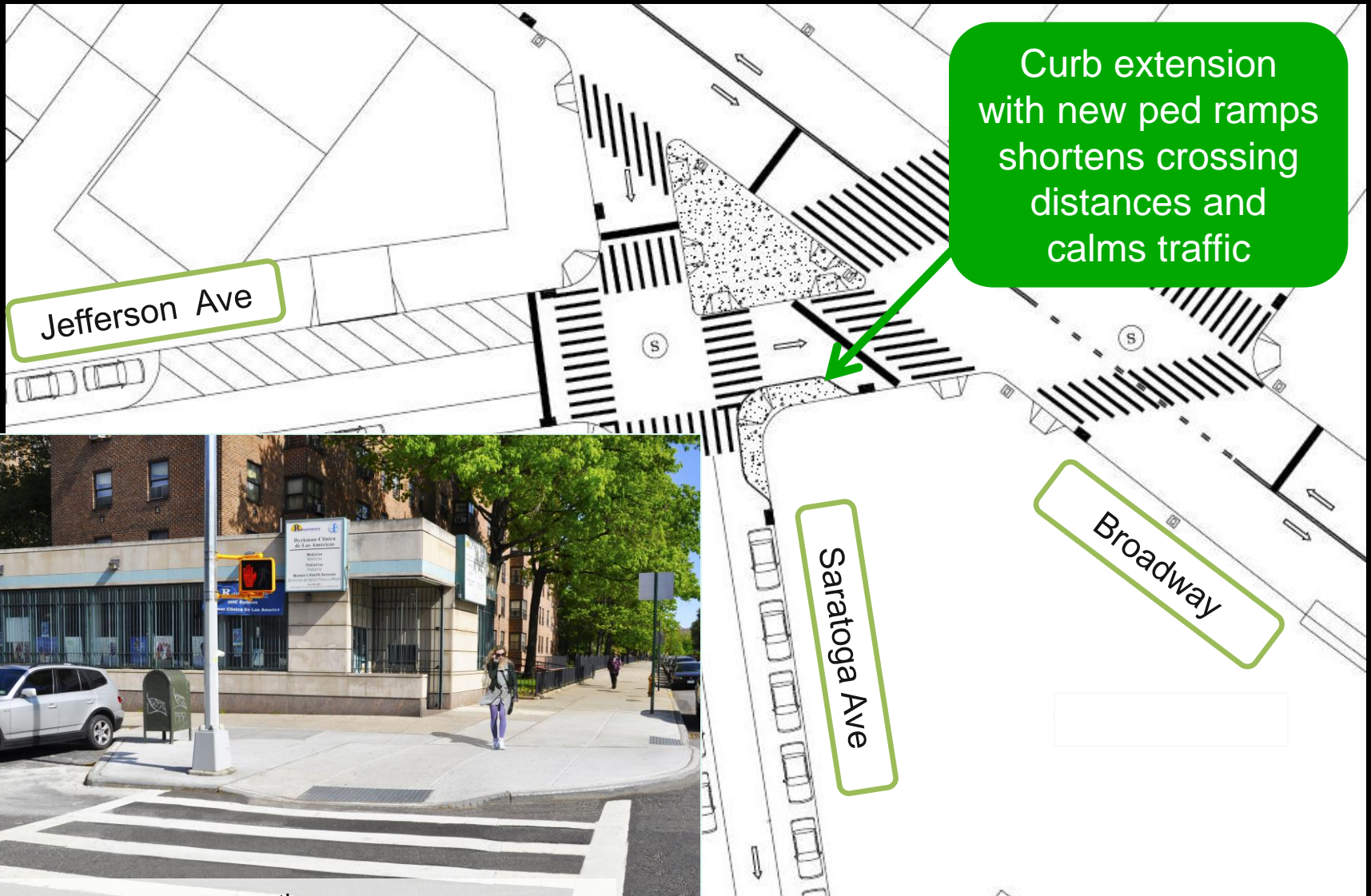
Concrete island with new ped ramps improves accessibility for pedestrians, particularly the elderly and people with disabilities



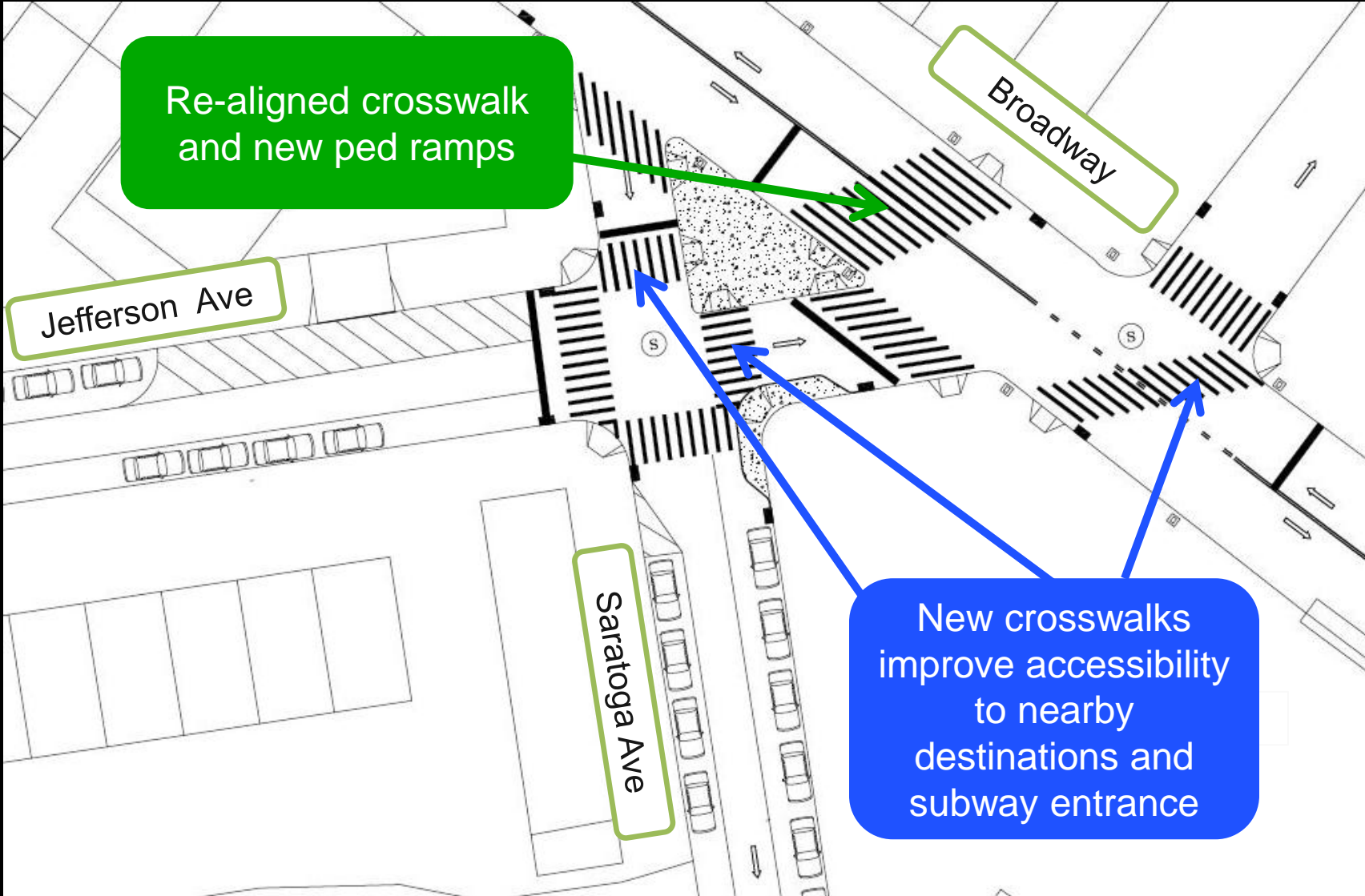
Crotona Park, Bronx

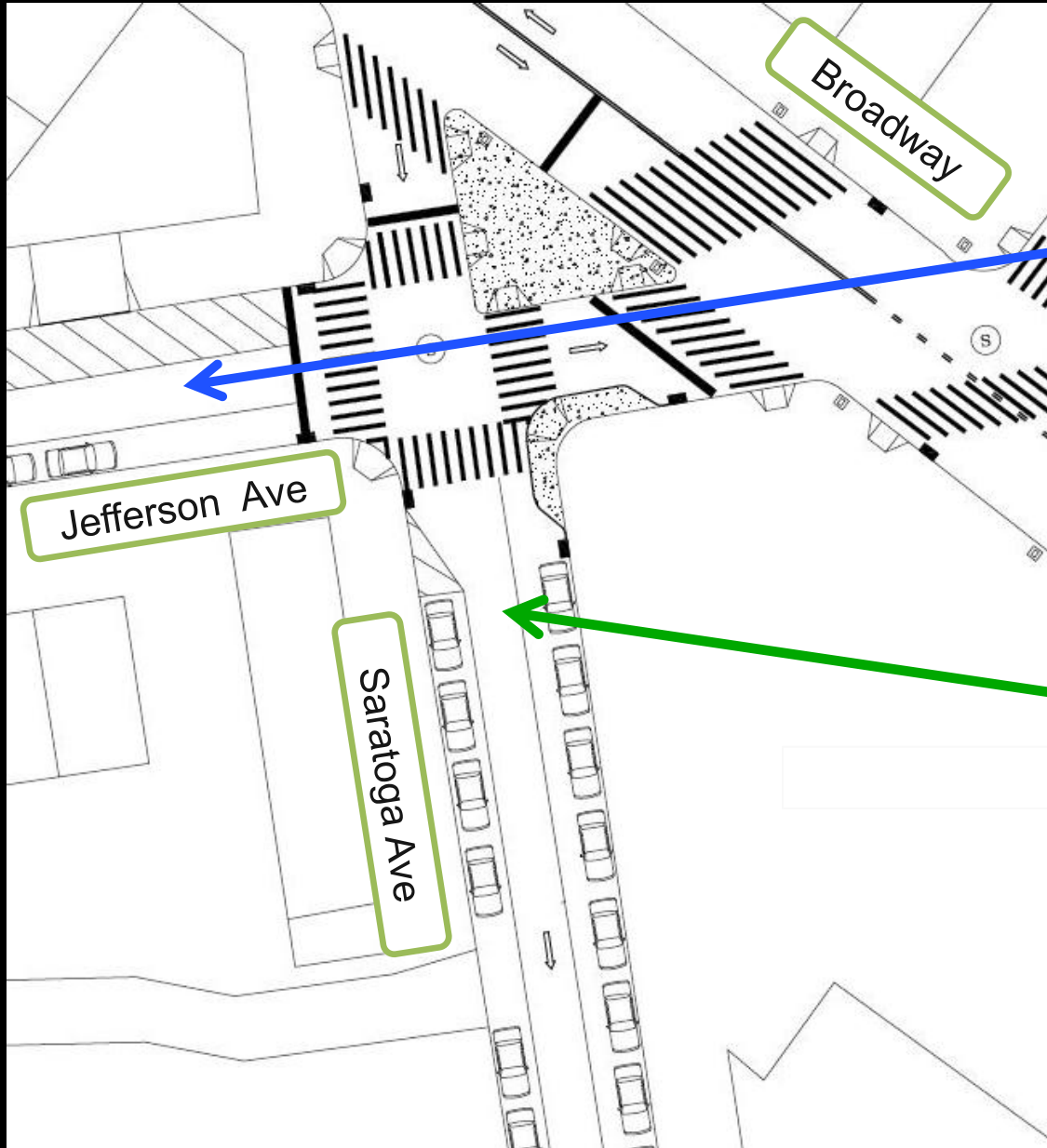


# 2. Pedestrian Crossings





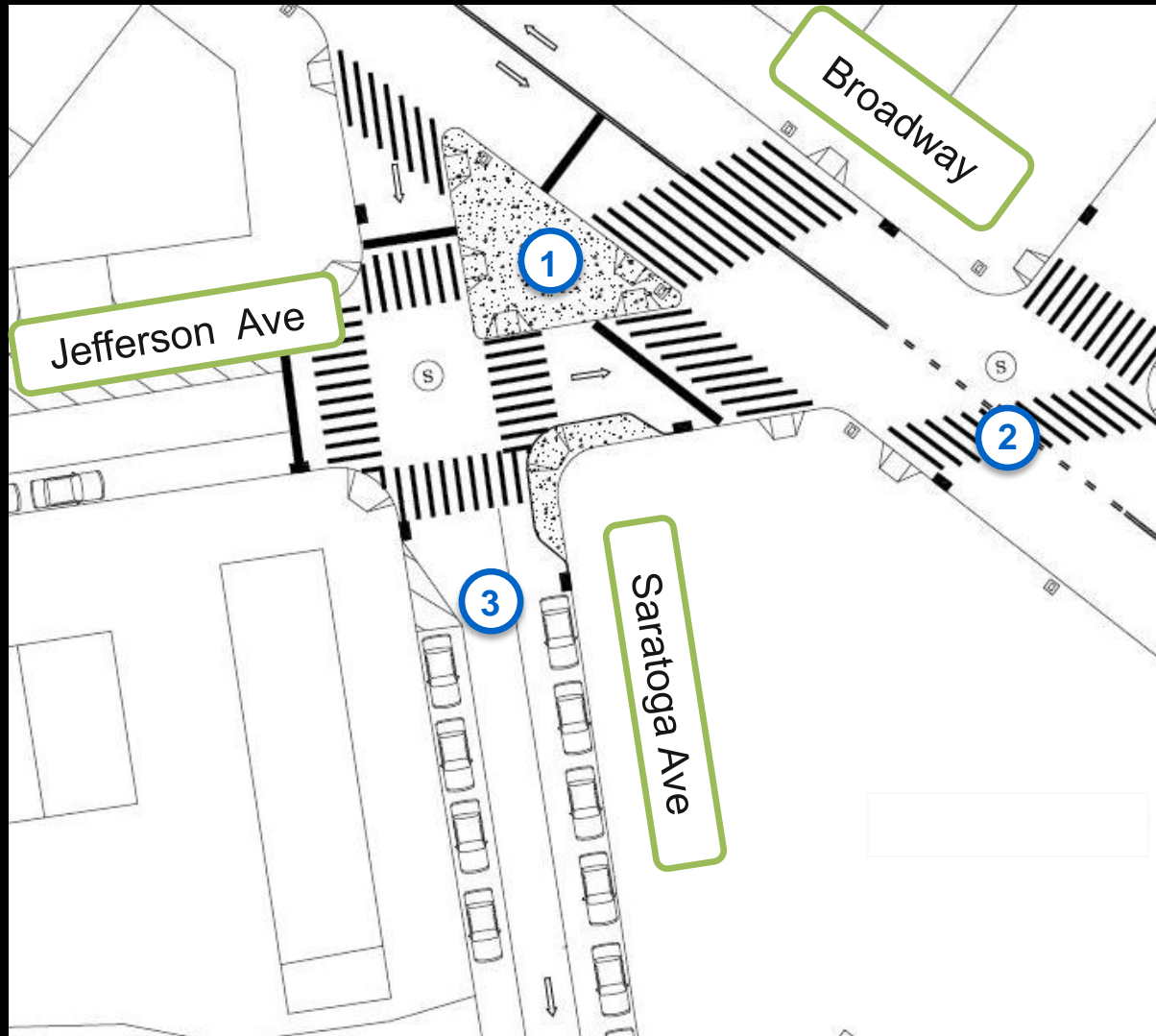
# 3. Traffic Safety

Convert Saratoga Ave substandard lanes to one 12' thru lane and two parking lanes

# Proposal Summary



- 1. Complete pedestrian island and construct curb extension**
- 2. Install new crosswalks**
- 3. Re-stripe Saratoga Ave**
