




## Project Background

- CB5 requested pedestrian safety improvements.
- I.S.119 is East of intersection of 73<sup>rd</sup> Pl and 78<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Many students cross intersection daily to and from school.
- Irregular, offset intersection:
  Cooper Ave and 78<sup>th</sup> Ave both T into 73<sup>rd</sup> Pl.
- Truck route on Cooper Ave connecting through 73<sup>rd</sup> PI.






## Pedestrian Counts


No crosswalk at point of highest volume

New island for pedestrian safety + blocks straight movement from 78<sup>th</sup> Avenue





Shorten crossing with expanded curb
