Summary of project:

This is the inaugural partnership with the Art Students League for a public art project. They hope their new course on public art, composed of seven accomplished artists, will teach the students career advancement and an understanding of working outside of the studio. In addition to Riverside South, close to the ASL campus, the artists will work together to create one monumental sculpture to be placed in Van Cortlandt at the same time (still in the design process).

The seven artists, though varied in specific theme and medium, are addressing the over-arching theme of water. This theme emerged naturally during the course of discussions about what the participating artists find unique and inspirational in the public space of Riverside Park.


Title: The Golden Fish Material: Plastic/acrylic




Description: Using the image of the bird, she will nod to the sites history as well as the City's future. Small
