

## Traffic Safety

The Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Police Department (NYPD) have joint responsibility for maintaining traffic safety. DOT is responsible for installing and maintaining traffic controls and safety devices, while the NYPD is responsible for enforcement of traffic regulations and hazardous driving violations.
