## EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 167

## REVOCATION OF EMERGENCY RESTRICTION ON EAST RIVER BRIDGES

November 2, 2012

WHEREAS, Executive Order 163 declares a state of emergency in the City of New York; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 165 sets forth a prohibition on passenger vehicles containing fewer than three persons entering Manhattan via the East River bridges, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, that prohibition can safely be revoked at 5 p.m. today,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

- § 1. Section 4 of Executive Order 165, as amended by Executive Order 166, is revoked.
  - § 2. This Order shall take effect at 5 p.m. on November 2, 2012.
