MR. MANDELL: We will now take up the matter of the Business Integrity Commission's staff recommendations for the denial of certain license and registration applications. The first matter of consideration is Queens County Carting, Inc., which applied to renew a registration to operate a trade waste business solely engaged in the removal of materials resulting from building demolition, construction, alteration, or excavation.

The staff has recommended denial of that registration renewal application for the

1	following independently sufficient grounds;
2	one, the applicant failed to disclose Anthony
3	LaPuma Sr. as their principal; and two,
4	Undisclosed Principal, Anthony LaPuma Sr.,
5	has been convicted of attempted falsifying
6	business records, a crime directly related to
7	the trade waste industry. Queens County
8	Carting, Inc. did not submit a response to
9	the staff's recommendation. A proposed
10	decision denying the registration renewal
11	application has been provided to the
12	Commissioners, or their designees, for their
13	review.
14	At this time, I'll ask whether there's

16	Inc.'s registration renewal application?

24	and misleading information on its
25	application; and three, the Applicant has

1	failed to demonstrate eligibility for a trade
2	waste license.
3	LVM Contracting LLC submitted a
4	response to the staff's recommendation, which
5	the Commission has considered. A proposed
6	decision denying the license application has
7	been provided to the Commissioners, or their
8	designees, for their review.
9	At this time, I'll ask whether there's
