NOTICE OF CHANGES TO THE BOARD

Board Member DeAnna Hoskins resigned from the Board of Correction ("BOC" or "Board") on September 30, 2024.

The Board recognizes and thanks former Board Member Hoskins for her commitment to advancing the Board's governance for the betterment of individuals working and living in the City's correctional facilities. Ms. Hoskins was appointed to the Board in February 2023. She later served as Vice Chair of the Board, helping to restore the Board's long-standing and unfettered access to the Department of Correction's ("Department" or "DOC") video footage systems.

Ms. Hoskins's work strengthened the Board's oversight authority. She addressed concerns regarding the Department's staffing conditions in the jails, encouraged DOC to improve programming services for incarcerated individuals, emphasized the importance of tracking sick call requests for those in custody, urged the development of a unified system to ensure all staff are scanned upon entering correctional facilities, was inclusive of stakeholder voices such as the Correction Officers' Benevolent Association ("COBA"), and raised concerns about the outdoor recreation designs for proposed borough-based jails.

Ms. Hoskins chaired the Board's Rulemaking Committee, which adopted rules to ensure compliance with Local Law 42 of 2024, and was a member of the Board's Women in Jails Committee. The Board sincerely thanks Ms. Hoskins for her contributions during her one-and-a-half years of service and wishes her the best in her future endeavors.
