

# Correctional Officer Training

DOC reports training information at the facility level for five specific jails:

- the only jail dedicated to women (RMSC); and
- four facilities with the highest proportions of Young Adults (AMKC, EMTC, RNDC, and OBCC).

## December 2018 SCM Training

The Department of Correction provided metrics on the SCM-trained correctional officers in 5 jails. These statistics do not differentiate between officers who work with the YA population and officers who do not.
