TPS + B4: How To Host Slides

Part 1: Introduction from The People's Supper (Slides 1-6)

In this video, we share some best practices around choosing questions that will guide conversations at your tables.





Part 7: <u>Host Facilitation Tips</u> (Slides 40-47)

In this video, we share some best practices around how to facilitate conversations at your table and what to do if/when moments of tension arise amongst group members.

In this video, we talk about the reflection process after a gathering and what next steps you can take as a community-based organization or table host to further connect with attendees and your broader community.
