M. Mauer and L. Luisi, on behalf of the Lieutenant Robert DiMartini family, submitted to the committee petitions and a biography for a street overlay in honor of Lieutenant DiMartini at City Island Avenue and

Carroll Street. The biography will remain in the Board Office. Mr. DiMartini was a lifelong New Yorker, City Island resident, and successful patrolman, sergeant and lieutenant in the 1970s and 1980s. Mr. DiMartini is credited with having oversaw successful anti-crime units at the New York City Police Department. Mr. DiMartini also proudly served his country overseas during the Vietnam War. The committee unanimously supported the following resolution. J. Grell proposed the motion. It was seconded by M. Caruso.

**Resolved**...at the recommendation of the Municipal Services Committee that there be a street overlay at the intersection of Carroll Street and City Island Avenue in honor of Lieutenant Robert DiMartini and that this be forwarded to the Full Board for its approval.
