ii. 211 East 203rd Street – The Bedford - 41 units available.

Housing Services Inc. provided updates for the soon to be completed building at the above reference address. The Bedford, a building with 107 units and 13 stories is looking for a LEED Platinum certification and to have a Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO) by mid-November for the first tenants to move in starting on January 15th, 2022. As of the date of this meeting management has received about 300 written applications and 10,000 applications via housing connect;



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however, they will continue to accept applications until November 15, 2021. The Bedford will have a front desk security, a superintendent, and a porter as part of their staff, as well as case workers for the supportive housing tenants in the building. https://housingconnect.nyc.gov/PublicWeb/details/2202

b. Construction Updates

i. 261 East 202nd Street / 270 East 203rd Street –

CAMBA provided an update on the construction progress of the two buildings, which are looking to receive LEED Gold Certification. The superstructure for both buildings is currently up to the eighth story. The building on 203rd Street will be topping off at the end of December 2021. The other building on 202nd Street will top off at stories in January 2022. Each building will have one superintendent and two porters once completed in 2023. committee inquired about any complaints they have received from neighbors; the team explained that other than parking and noise, the complaints have ceased. The team is in talk with neighbor to repair broken sidewalk damaged by construction trucks. CAMBA will be working with Art Bridge to install a temporary art piece on the buildings during construction. They will also be coming to CB7 to provide job fairs for both construction and the organization. www.camba.org/careers.
