**Description:** The City Charter establishes a District Service Cabinet (DSC) in each community district, to be composed of agency officials responsible for local service delivery. The District Manager of the Community Board chairs the District Service Cabinet, whose members include representatives of the agencies that deliver local services to the Community District. The District Service Cabinet is the primary mechanism through which local service delivery issues can be raised, discussed and resolved. If used effectively, the Cabinet can provide the basis for a comprehensive approach to service delivery within the community district.

- D. FDNY Fire Stats are as follows:

July 2024: Structure fires: The Bronx had 386 runs. CB 9 had 44. It increased by 12.8% compared to last year. The response time was 4:24.

EMS response: The Bronx had 5794 runs. CB 9 had 545. It increased by 10.3% compared to last year. The response time was 6:03.

August 2024: Structure fires: The Bronx had 431 runs. CB 9 had 43. It increased by 4.9% compared to last year. The response time was 5:03.

EMS response: The Bronx had 5601 runs. CB 9 had 524. It increased by 4.2% compared to last year. The response time was 5:55.

- E. Bronx DA 7<sup>th</sup> 5K Annual Run/Walk/Roll Against Domestic Violence will be taking place on Oct 26th from 9:30am-12:30PM. Event begins and ends on E.161<sup>st</sup> between Grand Concourse and Walton Ave.
- F. 43<sup>rd</sup> Pct NYPD Update, school dismissals have caused an increase in traffic but NYPD is aware and mitigating. Upcoming Events include Thank an Officer Day on Sat, Sept 21<sup>st</sup> all day at the 43<sup>rd</sup> Pct Station. In addition, there will be a Mexican Independence Celebration next Sunday on Morrison Ave taking place. Burglaries by the way of commercial vehicle have been common, if it continue to occur, NYPD will have to enforce no commercial parking on residential streets. Shooting are down 20% compared to last year.
