I. Introduction

- A. Committee Description:** The youth & education committee represents the community's interests with regards to education and programs that target the youth and acts as a liaison between community members and the NYC Department of Education including Parent Advocates, PTA's, Educators and Principals, School Safety, the Administration for Children Services, the District Attorney's Office, NYC department of Youth & Development and local organizations and nonprofits.

II. Speakers

A. Anthony Carrión, NYC Civic Engagement Commission

The NYC Civic Engagement Commission provides language assistance to voters with Limited English Proficiency during elections; Launches the People's Money: New York City's annual citywide Participatory Budgeting (PB) initiative where community members decide how to spend part of the city's budget; works with all 59 Boards across the city to provide assistance and training to community board members, such as workshops on uniform meeting procedures, the city budget, and community outreach; and hosts Special Initiatives.

The People's Money is a democratic process that is open to all New Yorkers, ages 11 and up, regardless of immigration status.

The People's Money Process: Phase 1: Idea Generation (Oct-Nov), Phase 2: Project Development (Jan-Feb), Phase 3 (April-June), Project Implementation (Next Year).

Whether you are an established 501(c)3 non-profit organization or a local community group (PTA, community board, block association, etc.) there are many ways to get involved with "the People's Money" and other civic engagement work via PB Partnership or Trie Partnership opportunities. The tickets are on sale for \$30 for ages 13 and over and half priced for children 5-13 years old; Children under 5 are free. Group rates are available for schools/large groups.
