



District Service Cabinet Summary

February 16, 2021 - 1:00 PM

Description: The City Charter establishes a District Service Cabinet (DSC) in each community district, to be composed of agency officials responsible for local service delivery. The District Manager of the Community Board chairs the District Service Cabinet, whose members include representatives of the agencies that deliver local services to the Community District. The District Service Cabinet is the primary mechanism through which local service delivery issues can be raised, discussed and resolved. If used effectively, the Cabinet can provide the basis for a comprehensive approach to service delivery within the community district.

III. Agency Reports /Announcements

- FDNY-Virtual CPR Trainings are now available. The importance of getting trained in CPR and AED instruction cannot be overstated and is proven invaluable in emergency situations. FDNY Mobile CPR Unit can help to learn what to do in case of a cardiac emergency. Scheduled classes begin take place every Tuesday and Thursday at 10am and 4pm. - FDNY- Fire stats for CB9 were discussed.
- NYPD- Inspector Keiyon Ramsey stated that there has been a spike in shootings. DM Rivera states we will be doing neighborhood zoom/webex meetings by NCO sectors. DM Rivera also stated that a CB9 newsletter will be mailed out with what is going on in the community. Lastly, DM Rivera stated that he will be having a clergy meeting with the Inspector and NCO Sgt.
- DFTA- Working with vaccine command center to step up vaccination and set up popups in senior buildings. Continuing outreach. DM stated that he wants to come up with a way to database vulnerable seniors in district.
- Mayor's Office – Ms. Miranda stated that if a Town Hall meetings needs to be scheduled in regards to the covid vaccine to reach out. Ms. Miranda also stated that local pharmacies have access to the vaccine.

- NYPL- The NYPL will continue to mail flyers for CB9 bulletin with online courses.
