Mayor's Office- Ms. Miranda stated that based on CDC guidance the J&J vaccine has been paused. If you have an appointment for a J&J vaccine, it will be replaced with either Pfizer or Moderna.

Bronx DA- Ms. Calderon stated that there will be a gun buyback and as soon as she gets updates, she will get the information out to e everyone. Ms. Calderon also stated that April is sexual harassment awareness month and there will be an event on April 15 at 6 pm. DEP- Effie stated that there has been several watermain breaks in the CB9 area. Ms. Aridizzone also stated that there is a seasonal position for city parks workers if anyone is interested. Senator Biaggi- Ms. Vasquez stated that the budget has passed, and office will make sure information will go out with rental assistance. Ms. Vasquez also stated that the J&J vaccine has been paused.

Assemblymember Kenneth Burgos- Jade Guzman stated, Assemblymember Kenneth Burgos received \$20k in funding for the castle hill YMCA. The state budget was also passed which includes \$1billion to support small business, \$2.4 billion in emergency rental assistance, increased taxes for New Yorkers making over \$1million; Corporate Franchise Tax will increase for corporations making over \$5million, Middle-Class New Yorkers will see tax cuts (income below 323k), legalization of Mobile Sports Betting, \$2.1 billion for the Excluded Worker Fund.
