- B. Andrew Hoyles-DSNY, Fall Leaf Collection & Curbside Composting
The NYC Department of Sanitation will resume curbside composting this fall!
Composting food scraps and yard waste helps make our neighborhoods cleaner and greener by creating nutrient-rich compost to be used on our city's gardens, yards and street trees, or clean energy to fuel our homes. To bring back the service more efficiently, residents will be required to sign up for service starting the first week of August, through a simple online form or by calling 311. Collections in eligible community districts starts in October on a rolling basis based on the number of sign ups. Service will expand each month as demand grows. *Flyers Attached
