1. Introduction

A. 2. Speakers/Presentations

- A. **Constance Barnes, The Knowledge House-** The Knowledge house is sponsored by French Montana. The Knowledge house has a STEM program with paid summer jobs for summer youth ages 16-20 and for those who are entering and already in college. There is also an adult program and digital reading program. The application deadline is May 30, 2021. The Knowledge house is looking to collaborate in the community.

- B. **Maria Matos, Census Data Dissemination Presentation-** Ms. Matos gave a presentation on the Census data dissemination. Ms. Matos spoke about the following:
 - The Decennial Census- This is a once-a-decade population and housing count required by the U.S constitution.
 - The Economic Census- Measures the nation's economy every five years, providing statistics for virtually every industry and geographic area in the country.
 - The Census of governments-Provide comprehensive data about the nearly 90,000 state and local governments in the nation every 5 years.
