Committee Description: The public safety & transportation committee represents the community's interests with regards to sanitation, crime, fire-ems, quality of life, NYS liquor license application recommendations, street activity permit applications, street re-naming application, transportation and acts as a liaison between community members and the New York Police Department & Fire Departments, NYC Department of Environmental Protection, NYC Department of Sanitation, NYC Department of Transportation, NYC Department of Sanitation & NYS Liquor Authority.

I. Speakers

- A. DEP, Harbour Pointe/Shorehaven Regulator Replacement (Presentation was emailed to CB9)**- A presentation was given on Harbour Pointe/Shorehaven Regulator Replacement. The project purpose is to improve New York waterways by reducing combined sewer overflows. Improve capacity in HP-007 and HP-009 project areas. Provide CSO "floatables" relief in the HO-011 project area. Combined sewer overflow is when the sewer system is at full capacity, a diluted mixture of rainwater and sewage may be released into local waterways. This is called a combined sewer overflow. 65% to 90% of combined sanitary and storm flow in NYC is captured and sent to treatment plants, the rest discharges to water bodies.
- B. Carlos Castell Croke, New York League of Conservation Voters, NYCSBUS Electrification and Mobility Hub Project-** Mr. Croke gave a presentation on NYCSBUS Electrification and Mobility Hub Project (Presentation was emailed to CB9). Why clean school buses?
- Toxic Fumes are 4x higher in diesel-powered school buses than passenger cars.
 - Asthmas is the #1 causes of absences among children, aggravated by air pollution from diesel exhaust.
 - Diesel school buses expose kids to exhaust 23-46x higher than EPA listed as significant cancer risk.
 - Diesel exhaust contains >40 toxic air contaminants, like arsenic, benzene, and formaldehyde
