# Parks & Recreation Committee Meeting Summary March 13, 2024

## I. Introduction

**A. Committee Description**: The Parks and Recreation Committee represents the community's interests with regard to parks, park services and all park-related matters and acts as a liaison between parks users and the New York City Parks Department.

# II. Speakers

**A. NYC DEP, HP-009 Soundview Park project** (Presentation attached)- The Project Purpose is to Improve New York waterways by reducing combined sewer overflows (CSOs). Improve sewer capacity in HP-007 and HP-009 Project Areas and provide CSO "floatables" relief in the HP-011 Project Area. NYC's sewer system is approximately 60% combined, which means it is used to convey both sanitary and storm flows to the treatment plant. When the sewer system is at full capacity, a diluted mixture of rainwater and sewage may be released into local waterways. This is called a combined sewer overflow (CSO). 65% to 90% of combined sanitary & storm flow in NYC is captured and sent to treatment plants, the rest discharges to water bodies.
