Youth & Education Committee Meeting Summary June 13, 2024

I. Introduction

A. Committee Description: The youth & education committee represents the community's interests with regards to education and programs that target the youth and acts as a liaison between community members and the NYC Department of Education including Parent Advocates, PTA's, Educators and Principals, School Safety, the Administration for Children Services, the District Attorney's Office, NYC department of Youth & Development and local organizations and nonprofits.

II. Speakers

A. Rita Weston, Special Education Community Liaison - Motivated Care

Motivated Care began as an advocacy group for parents when the organization's CEO had trouble getting services for his child with an IEP. Motivated Care assist families with getting services for a child's IEP as well as getting an IEP if needed. They have educators, social workers, case managers, and a legal team and offer workshops, provide speech and OT, advocate for children and provide an array of other support services. All services provided are free and Motivated Care works with families of all school types; public, charter, private, etc. Motivated Care partners with NeON Arts, a program of the New York City Department of Probation (DOP). CB9 to invite Motivated Care to table at future events in the district.

B. Alfred McDowell, New Path Horse Academy/Light House Community Church Mr. McDowell shared that Light House Community Church will be renting space at the Fellowship Covenant Church on Castle Hill and the parish wants to connect further with BXCB9 participants to determine how they can provide needed services to adults, seniors and the youth. Mr. McDowell also runs a nonprofit that focuses on horseback riding programs for the youth. Potential for Mr. McDowell to partner with CB9 for Back to School Event.
