- **Speakers/Presentations** A. Rachel Navarro, Street Renaming Request

As per Rachel Navarro, she is requesting a street renaming for Uncle David Gansy, who passed away 6 months ago. She wants to rename Bruckner Blvd and Havemeyer Ave, outside of the liquor store before the service road. Her uncle was legally disabled.

As per DM Rivera, they would need a biography. He recommends bringing in a biography and he will have to review it with the committee. The criteria includes 10 years of community service or something community oriented.

- **New Business:** A. As per Angela, she wants no pedestrian crossing signs on all 4 corners of Bruckner Blvd on Olmstead.
- **Liquor Licenses:** A. Salome Latin Cuisine, Renewal

As per DM Rivera, there hasn't been any incidents over the 4 years. This is the second renewal. They have security over the weekends and there are security cameras. DM's recommendation is that there shouldn't be any objections. The application was sent to the precinct beforehand. There are no objections to the liquor license renewal. As per Salome, they close at 2 AM on Tuesday and Wednesday and they close at 4 AM from Thursday to Sunday.

- **DM Update:**

A. Alternative to Congestion Pricing: As per DM Rivera, there has been a suggestion sent to us to replace congestion pricing with a sales tax increase.

B. Office: As per DM Rivera, we are still working with DCAS for the new office and will be moving back soon across the hall. As per DM Rivera, we are also working on the Community Appreciation Dinner. As per DM Rivera, we also updated our software for CBMS.

D. Drag Racing As per DM Rivera, there is drag racing in the parking lot and the police are handling it. As per officer, they push them to different places but let them set up before getting the cars and holding them as long as they can be legally held. They get arrested for reckless endangerment.
