1. Old Business

- A. 7 Days Hotel update from CO: Take down of 9 members of the Hunts Point Gang that were using hotel for sex trafficking and prostitution took place recently, lock up of individuals took place, this was an active investigation and on Dec 16th the case was tackled and closed down. Shootings could not be tied into this.
- B. On Dec 31st second operation took place at the hotel, one individual wanted for domestic assault was arrested
- C. CO will be meeting with hotel to screen patrons and underage girls
- D. As per BM Juan Torres who is responsible to license hotel? As per CO, Consumer Affairs
- E. CO wants an inspection of this site and is currently working well with security at the site

2. DM Update

- A. Jan 4th Nite Life meeting with local businesses and 43 Pct went well. Meet and great with 43rd Pct CO, SLA matters and covid safety were discussed.
- B. January 6th rank choice voting webinar took place to inform public of this new process.
- C. CB9 in collaboration with Community partners distributed over 700 turkeys and 2000 toys throughout the holiday season, including 160 hygiene bags for our veterans at the Commonwealth Veterans Residence and toys to the North Central Pediatric Emergency room
- D. CB9 is still helping Rap4Bronx with food distribution every week as well as food pantries throughout the district.
- E. The office construction has been completed and awaiting for equipment and furniture to arrive due to covid related delays (3 to 4 months). Planned move to new office to occur during the summer.
