Monthly Board Meeting - Minutes

April 21, 2020 Webex Conference

The meeting was called to order at 6:04pm, by Chairperson Theresa Scavo. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairperson Scavo, asked for a moment of silence to respect all those lives lost to the Covid-19 Pandemic, especially for Board Member Jack Kishk who recently lost his mother to the virus and for Manhattan Beach activist Marilyn Chernin

Sam Chuprik representing Congressman Hakeem Jeffries office stated the Congressman was going to hold another Town Hall but with a focus on public housing, NYCHA. He also wants to make sure that postal workers are also provided with the proper safety equipment they require as well to stay safe as essential workers.
