 - a. Chair, Yaacov Behrman called the committee meeting to order at 7:05pm

 - a. Murder suspect in Empire Blvd shooting apprehended

 - c. Working with organizations such as Elite Learners, Inc. to assist with intervention measures – such as gang activity in Ebbets Field

 - i. Seeking renewal of Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider license
 - ii. Operates the café at the Lefrak Center at Prospect Park

 1. Concerns in connection with one the establishments door with access to the building vestibule remaining secure
 2. Building residents note that there has been improvement but there are still concerns.
 3. Owners have advised that they have purchased a limiter on their sound system that would keep them at the legal limit
 4. Vice-Chair Rashidah Siddiqui requested that the initial application be resent to the Committee to confirm their initial stated used of sound.
 5. Committee Chair Behrman will organize a site-visit to Gaia Nomaya to assess the sound system.
