- ii. Born June 24, 1995; Died December 20, 2021, after a confrontation with the NYPD in the Utica Avenue train station (3/4) during a reported mental crisis
- iii. Lifelong resident of 1090 Eastern Parkway. Attended St. Gregory Catholic School and then CUNY- College of Staten Island
- iv. Civically engaged
- v. The family would like this situation to bring awareness and policy change regarding how the NYPD response to call where mental health is a factor
