The Proposed *Annual Action Plan* is required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). It consolidates the statutory requirements of the Cranston-Gonzalez Housing Act's Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy, and the City's annual application for the four HUD Office of Community Planning and Development's entitlement programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships, Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).

The Proposed Action Plan serves not only as the City's application for the funds, but also as the HOPWA grant application for the New York HOPWA Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area (HOPWA EMSA). The HOPWA EMSA will be comprised of the five boroughs of the City of New York, as well as three upstate New York counties (Westchester, Rockland and Putnam).

The Public Hearing has been scheduled to obtain comments on the formulation of the plan and on the City's use of federal funds to address housing, services for the homeless, supportive housing service and community development needs, affirmatively further fair housing, and the development of proposed activities. In addition, agency representatives may receive comments on the City's performance of

For Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2022, the City received from HUD \$304,212,902 for the four HUD formula grant programs: \$166,259,543 for CDBG; \$81,327,120 for HOME; \$41,777,058 for HOPWA; and \$14,849,181 for ESG, respectively. Congress has yet to pass the FFY 2023 HUD Appropriations Bill. As a result, the actual grant amounts that the City will receive for 2023 remain to be determined.

The Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) is New York City's framework to promote community engagement for all citizens to exercise their voice and influence decisions that affect their communities, neighborhoods, and quality of life and guide the use of funding received from the Community Planning and Development (CPD) formula entitlement grant programs administered by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program, Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program, and Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) Program.

The City of New York proposes to substantially amend its Citizen Participation Plan (CPP).
