Required Sign for Chain Stores

New York City Air Conditioning Law

- Stores with five or more locations in New York City must conspicuously post on all exterior doors a sign that alerts people to contact 311 to report violations of the City's Air Conditioning Law.
- Stores are responsible for producing and posting the attached required sign, which DCWP created. *Note:*
 - The sign is 5.5 inches wide by 8.5 inches tall. Stores can produce signs to be proportionately larger.
 - The attached file includes two signs per page with a clear trim line. To print double-sided, select Short Edge Binding.
 - Sign must be in color.
 - You can produce the sign as a double-sided, opaque sign or window cling (for glass doors).
