Subject: Notice of a Public Hearing on a proposal to, in accordance with Section 931 of the County Law, amend the classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York, under the heading THE OFFICE OF THE NEW YORK COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY (901), in the Non-Competitive Class, subject to Rule XI, Part 1, under the title of Supervising Rackets Investigator (30832), by granting statutory authority to the Mayor of the City of New York to, with the consent of the District Attorney, increase or decrease the number of positions, and the term, grade, salary, and compensation of these positions.

The Deputy Commissioner of Human Capital, Department of Citywide Administrative Services has scheduled a Public Hearing to be held on August 15, 2017, at 10:00 AM, 125 Worth Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Auditorium, New York, NY 10013 on a proposal to amend the classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York.
