

NOTICE OF A FRANCHISE AND CONCESSION REVIEW COMMITTEE ("FCRC") PUBLIC HEARING to be held on Monday July 12, 2010 commencing at 2:30 P.M. at 22 Reade Street, Borough of Manhattan, on the following three items relating to changes in the ownership structure of three franchises currently held by direct and indirect subsidiaries of RCN Corporation ("RCN Corp"): (1) a change of control of RCN New York Communications, LLC ("RCN-NYC"), which is a current franchisee, whereby RCN Corp will replace RCN Telecom Services, Inc. as the immediate parent of RCN-NYC, ABRY Partners VI, L.P. will obtain sole indirect voting control of RCN Corp, and ABRY Partners VI, L.P. and ABRY Senior Equity III, L.P. will hold a majority interest in RCN Corp, thus replacing RCN Corp as the ultimate parent entities of RCN-NYC; (2) an assignment by RCN Telecom Services, Inc. ("RCN-TS"), which is a current franchisee, of its New York City franchise and assets to a newly formed company, RCN Telecom Services of New York, LP ("RCN-TSNY"), and a change of control whereby RCN Telecom Services, LLC ("RCN LLC") will become the general partner of RCN-TSNY and ABRY Partners VI, L.P. will obtain sole indirect voting control of and hold an indirect majority interest in RCN LLC, with ABRY Partners VI, L.P. becoming the ultimate parent entity of RCN LLC; and (3) change of control of NEON Transcom, Inc. ("NEON"), which is a current franchisee, whereby ABRY Partners VI, L.P. will obtain sole indirect voting control of RCN Corp, and ABRY Partners VI, L.P. and ABRY Senior Equity III, L.P will hold a majority interest in RCN Corp, thus replacing RCN Corp as the ultimate parent entities of NEON.

Regarding item number (1), on March 6, 2006, the FCRC held a public hearing regarding the transfer of control of the parent company of Con Edison Communications, LLC to RCN Corporation and name change, to RCN New York Communications, LLC, of a franchisee originally granted a franchise that was approved by the FCRC on September 22,2000 (Cal. No. 1) and pursuant to which the franchisee is authorized to install, operate and maintain facilities on, over and under the City's inalienable property to provide telecommunications services as defined in the franchise agreement.

Regarding item number (2), on December 9, 1998 (Cal. No. 3), the FCRC approved a franchise between the City and RCN Telecom Services of New York, Inc., (which later changed its name to RCN Telecom Services, Inc.), pursuant to which the company is authorized to install, operate and maintain facilities on, over and under the City's inalienable property to provide telecommunications services as defined in the franchise agreement.

Regarding item number (3), on June 4, 2008 (Cal. No. 1), the FCRC approved an amendment to Appendix G of the franchise agreement and approved change of control of a franchise held by NEON whereby RCN Corp became the ultimate parent company of NEON. NEON is the current holder, after previous changes approved by the FCRC, of the franchise originally granted to Columbia Transmission Communications Corporation on April 12, 2000. Pursuant to this franchise, NEON is authorized to install, operate and maintain facilities on, over and under the City's inalienable property to provide telecommunications services as defined in the franchise agreement.

A copy of the existing franchise agreements and an ownership organization chart reflecting the proposed changes of control ("proposed organizational chart") may be viewed at DoITT, 75 Park Place, 9th Floor, New York, New York 10007, commencing Friday, June 18 2010 through Monday July 12, 2010, between the hours of 9:30 A.M. and 3:30 P.M., excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. NOTICE OF PROMULGATION OF AMENDMENTS TO RULES PERTAINING TO REMOVAL OF VIOLATIONS ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING MAINTENANCE CODE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of the Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("Department") by Chapter 61 of the New York City Charter and §27-2090 of the New York City Administrative Code that the Department hereby adopts amendments to Chapter 9 of Title 28 of the Official Compilation of Rules of the City of New York concerning removal of violations issued pursuant to the Housing Maintenance Code. The proposed amendments are underlined, and deleted material is indicated by brackets. A public hearing was held on June 11, 2010 at 100 Gold Street, New York, N.Y.

Section 1. Section 9-02 of Chapter 9 of Title 28 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§9-02 Eligible Applicants.

- (a) The Department will accept Dismissal Requests from owners, [or] managing agents, or the authorized representatives of such owners or managing agents for reinspections of properties in each of the five boroughs of the City of New York.
- (1) Owners and managing agents of multiple dwellings must be registered with the Department in accordance with the provisions of §§27-2097 through 27-2099 of the Housing Maintenance Code in order to submit a Dismissal Request.
- (2) Owners of co-operative and condominium units and private dwellings must submit proof of ownership satisfactory to the Department in order to submit a Dismissal Request
- (3) Authorized representatives of owners or managing agents who are registered in accordance with the provisions of §§27-2097 through 27-2099 of the Housing Maintenance Code must submit proof of such authorization satisfactory to the Department in order to submit a Dismissal Request.
- §2. Section 9-06 of Chapter 9 of Title 28 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§9-06 Exceptions to the Dismissal Request Procedure.
(a) The application for a Dismissal Request by an owner, [or] managing agent, or the authorized representative of such owner or managing agent who is otherwise eligible to apply for a Dismissal Request pursuant to the foregoing provisions of these rules may be rejected by the Department where the building that is the subject of the application is a building for which:

- (1) there is pending Department-related litigation; or
- (2) there is an uncollected judgment arising from Department-related litigation; or
- (3) there is an unpaid emergency repair charge for repairs performed by or on behalf of the Department.

#### STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE

The amendments to these rules clarify that a registered owner or managing agent may authorize a representative to apply to the Department for dismissal of violations that have been corrected. The representative will be required to present proof of authorization from the owner or managing agent. This amendment will assist owners and managing agents in seeking dismissal of violations of the Housing Maintenance Code in order to ensure that the violation records on their buildings are accurate and up to date.

The proposal involves an application by the New York City Department of City Planning ("DCP") for a text amendment to portions of the zoning regulations for Special Hudson Yards District, the Special West Chelsea District, the Special Garment District and the Special Clinton District. The area affected by the proposed text amendments are generally bounded by West 16th Street on the south, Eighth Avenue on the east, West 42nd Street on the north and Eleventh Avenue on the west, in Community District 4.

The Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement ("FGEIS") for the No. 7 Subway Extension-Hudson Yards Rezoning and Development Program was certified as complete on November 8, 2004 by the City Planning Commission ("CPC") and the Metropolitan Transportation Authority ("MTA"), acting as co-lead agencies. On January 19, 2005, the City Council approved Application No. N040500 (A) ZRM and related actions, which together refer to the establishment of the Special Hudson Yards District and other rezoning actions on the Far West Side of Midtown Manhattan. The approved actions consist of Alternative S, which was analyzed in Chapter 26, "Alternatives," of the FGEIS, together with modifications to Alternative S made by the City Planning Commission and City Council and assessed in Technical Memoranda, dated November 17, 2004, January 14, 2005, August 4, 2005 and September 14, 2005. Additionally, Follow-Up Corrective Actions (FUCAs) to the Hudson Yards Zoning text were adopted by the City Council in 2005 and 2008.

The Final Environmental Impact Statement ("FEIS") for Special West Chelsea District Rezoning and High Line Open Space Final Environmental Impact Statement was certified as complete on December 20, 2004 by the City Planning Commission ("CPC"). On June 23, 2005, the City Council approved Application Nos. N050161ZRM, 050162ZMM, 050163PCM. Additionally, a FUCA to the West Chelsea Zoning text was adopted by the City Council in 2006.

Since that time, additional text changes were also identified to clarify the text, eliminate inaccurate references in the text and add new provisions for the Special Hudson Yards District, the Special West Chelsea District, the Special Garment District and the Special Clinton District. The following is a list of the two principal proposed zoning text changes analyzed in the technical memorandum:

- 1) Facilitate the construction of the above-grade infrastructure necessary for access and operation of the No. 7 Subway extension. (Sections 93-14, 93-65, 96-21, 98-65)
- 2) Address community concerns that the significant growth forecasted for the Hudson Yards and adjacent areas, should it occur, could result in development pressure that may affect tenement housing that has historically provided an affordable housing resource for residents. (Sections 93-91, 96-108, 98-70, 121-50)

The Environmental Assessment and Review Division of the Department of City Planning, on behalf of the City Planning Commission, has reviewed the Technical Memorandum. The Technical Memorandum represents a minor modification and does not alter the conclusions of our earlier review. Therefore, the Notices of Completion of the Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement for the No. 7 Subway Extension-Hudson Yards Rezoning and Development Program issued on November 8, 2004, and the Special West Chelsea District Rezoning and High Line Open Space Final Environmental Impact Statement issued on December 20, 2004, both remain valid.

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### READER'S GUIDE

The City Record (CR) is, published each business day and includes notices of proposed New York City procurement actions, contract awards, and other procurement-related information. Solicitation notices for most procurements valued at or above \$100,000 for information technology and for construction and construction related services, above \$50,000 for other services, and above \$25,000 for other goods are published for at least one day. Other types of procurements, such as sole source, require notice in the City Record for five consecutive days. Unless otherwise specified, the agencies and offices listed are open for business Mondays thru Fridays from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. except legal holidays.

#### NOTICE TO ALL NEW YORK CITY CONTRACTORS

The New York State Constitution ensures that all laborers. workers or mechanics employed by a contractor or subcontractor doing public work are to be paid the same wage rate that prevails in the trade where the public work is being done. Additionally, New York State Labor Law §§ 220 and 230 provide that a contractor or subcontractor doing public work in construction or building service must pay its employees no less than the prevailing wage. Section 6-109 (the Living Wage Law) of the New York City Administrative Code also provides for a "living wage", as well as prevailing wage, to be paid to workers employed by City contractors in certain occupations. The Comptroller of the City of New York is mandated to enforce prevailing wage. Contact the NYC Comptrollers Office at www.comptroller.nyc.gov, click on Labor Law Schedules to view rates

New York City's "Burma Law" (Local Law No. 33 of 1997) No Longer to be Enforced. In light of the United States Supreme Court's decision in **Crosby v. National Foreign Trade Council**, 530 U.S. 363 (2000), the City has determined that New York City's Local Law No. 33 of 1997 (codified in Administrative Code Section 6-115 and Charter Section 1524), which restricts City business with banks and companies doing business in Burma, is unconstitutional. This is to advise, therefore, that the language relating to Burma contained in existing New York City contracts may not be enforced

# CONSTRUCTION/CONSTRUCTION SERVICES OR CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES

The City of New York is committed to achieving excellence in the design and construction of its capital program, and building on the tradition of innovation in architecture and engineering that has contributed to the City's prestige as a global destination.

### VENDOR ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

New York City procures approximately \$7 billion worth of goods, services, construction and construction-related services every year. The NYC Procurement Policy Board Rules require that agencies primarily solicit from established mailing lists called bidder/proposer lists. To register for these lists--free of charge-, prospective suppliers should fill out and submit the NYC-FMS Vendor Enrollment application.

Even if you already do business with NYC agencies, be sure to fill out an application. We are switching over to citywide, centralized Bidders Lists instead of the agency-specific lists previously used to issue notices about upcoming contract opportunities. To continue receiving notices of New York City contract opportunities, you must fill out and submit a NYC-FMS Vendor Enrollment application.

### PRE-QUALIFIED LIST

New York City procurement policy permits agencies to develop and solicit from pre-qualified lists of vendors, under prescribed circumstance. When it is decided by an agency to develop a pre-qualified list, criteria for pre-qualification must be clearly explained in the solicitation and notice of the opportunity to pre-qualify for that solicitation must be published in at least five issues of the  $\it CR$ .

Information and qualification questionnaires for inclusion on such list may be obtained directly from the Agency Chief Contracting Officer at each agency, (see Vendor Information Manual). A completed qualification Questionnaire may be submitted to the Chief Contracting Officer at any time, unless otherwise indicated and action (approval or denial) shall be taken by the agency within 90 days from the date of submission. Any denial or revocation of pre-qualified status can be appealed to the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings, (OATH), Section 3-11 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules describes the criteria for the general use of pre-qualified lists.

#### NON-MAYORAL ENTITIES

The following agencies are not subject to Procurement Policy Board rules and do not follow all of the above procedures: City University, Department of Education, Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Health & Hospitals Corporation, Housing Authority. Suppliers interested in applying for inclusion on bidders list should contact these entities directly (see Vendor Information Manual) at the addresses given.

#### PUBLIC ACCESS CENTER

The Public Access Center is available to suppliers and the public as a central source for supplier-related information through on-line computer access. The Center is located at 253 Broadway, 9th floor, in lower Manhattan, and is open Monday through Friday from 10:00 A.M to 3:00 P.M. ## ATTENTION: NEW YORK CITY MINORITY AND WOMEN OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

Join the growing number of Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprises (M/WBEs) that are competing for New York City's business. In order to become certified for the program, your company must substantiate that it: (1) is at least fifty-one percent (51%) owned, operated and controlled by a minority or woman and (2) is either located in New York City or has a significant tie to New York City's business community. #### PROMPT PAYMENT

It is the policy of the City of New York to pay its bills promptly. The Procurement Policy Board Rules generally require that the City pay its bills within 30 days after the receipt of a proper invoice. The City now pays interest on all late invoices. The grace period that formerly existed was eliminated on July 1, 2000. However, there are certain types of payments that are not eligible for interest. These are listed in Section 4-06 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules. The Comptroller and OMB determine the interest rate on late payments twice a year, in January and in July.

#### HOW TO READ CR PROCUREMENT NOTICES

Procurement Notices in the CR are arranged by alphabetically listed Agencies, and within Agency, by Division if any. The notices for each Agency (or Division) are further divided into three subsections: Solicitations, Awards; and Lists & Miscellaneous notices. Each of these subsections separately lists notices pertaining to Goods, Services, or Construction.

Notices of Public Hearings on Contract Awards appear at the end of the Procurement Section. At the end of each Agency (or Division) listing is a paragraph giving the specific address to contact to secure, examine and/or to submit bid or proposal documents, forms, plans, specifications, and other information, as well as where bids will be publicly opened and read. This address should be used for the purpose specified UNLESS a different one is given in the individual notice. In that event, the directions in the individual notice should be followed. The following is a SAMPLE notice and an explanation of the notice format used by the CR.
