Pursuant to Section 3-11 of the PPB Rules, The New York City Police Department ("NYPD") is seeking to enter into a contract for a Demonstration Project with ShotSpotter, Inc. (DBA SST, Inc.), 7979 Gateway Blvd., Newark, CA 94560, for a Gunshot Detection and Location System (the "System"). The NYPD is seeking to enter into a contract for the implementation of the System as a 2-Year Demonstration Project covering up to 15 Square miles of New York City. The proposed System would use specially placed microphones to pinpoint, in seconds, the precise location of gunfire within the coverage areas. The System will also include an adjudication capability in which analysts will listen to each recorded alert and screen out false positives (such as fireworks). The purpose of the System is to both detect and to deter gunfire activity, including drug-related and "celebratory" gunfire that may terrorize communities or end in tragic deaths.

ShotSpotter, has developed a gunshot detection and location system that utilizes an entirely different technological, adjudicatory, and financial model from other such systems that have been tried unsuccessfully in the past by the NYPD. ShotSpotter uses a network of sensors (15-20 per square mile) that are affixed to rooftops and other high points. The system uses triangulation to determine the exact location from which a shot was fired. ShotSpotter also employs a team of analysts, stationed at a round-the-clock adjudication center, to listen to the sounds that prompted each alert. Adding human judgment to the process should drastically reduce the number of false positives. The Department is not aware of any other vendor which offers a gunshot detection system utilizing a technological and adjudicatory approach similar to that of ShotSpotter, Inc.

The Demonstration period will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of such a system within the environment of New York City. If the System proves to be a success, then the NYPD currently plans to do a competitive solicitation for the implementation of a Gunshot Detection and Location System over a larger coverage area.

This rule was first published on May 15, 2014 and a public hearing thereon was held on June 17, 2014.

Statement of Basis and Purpose

The Department of Buildings ("Department") is amending sections 104-01 and 104-02, and repealing sections 19-02, 19-03, and 19-04, of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York ("Rules").

The Department amends section 104-01, regarding examination and investigation requirements for Department licenses, by clarifying examination and investigation procedures. Some Department license examinations were previously administered by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, but all such examinations are now being administered by the Department. These amendments accommodate the additional license examinations.

The Department amends section 104-02, regarding required insurance for trade licensees, by clarifying the requirements for commercial general liability insurance.

The Department also repeals sections 19-02, 19-03, and 19-04, as these provisions are addressed elsewhere in the New York City Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") or the Rules.

- Section 19-02 concerns continuing education requirements for master plumbers and master fire suppression piping contractors. The substance of this rule is now addressed in section 105-03 of the Rules, effective September 15, 2013, which outlines the requirements for Department-approved courses.
- Section 19-03 concerns exemptions from Department inspection and testing requirements for minor plumbing work. These exemptions are provided by section 28-105.4.4 of the Administrative Code.
- Section 19-04 concerns the master plumber and master fire suppression piping contractor license board's authority to review master plumber and master fire suppression piping contractor license applications. The substance of this rule has been already codified under Article 417 of Chapter 4 of the Administrative Code and section 104-01(c) of Title 1 of the Rules.

The Department's authority for these rules is found in sections 643 and 1043 of the New York City Charter and sections 27-3005, 28-401.5, 28-401.6, 28-401.7, 28-401.8, and 28-401.9 of the Administrative Code.

[Deleted material is in brackets.]

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Section 1. Sections 19-02, 19-03, and 19-04 of title 1 of the rules of the City of New York, relating to requirements for master plumbers and master fire suppression piping contractors, are REPEALED.

§2. Section 104-01 of title 1 of the rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 104-01 Examinations and Other Qualifications

(a) Applicability. This subchapter shall apply to all licenses issued by the Department, except where otherwise specified.

(b) Definitions.

(1) For purposes of this subchapter, the terms "City," "Commissioner" and "Department" shall have the same meanings as set forth in §28-101.5 of the Administrative Code.

(2) For purposes of this subchapter, the term "license" shall [have the same meaning as is set forth] include any license as defined in §28-401.3 of the Administrative Code, except that the term shall include "certificate of competence" whenever such a certificate is required by Chapter 4 of title 28 of the Administrative Code, and any Master Electrician's License and Special Electrician's License as defined in §27-3004 of the Administrative Code.

(b) (c) Examinations.

(1) **Applicability.** This subdivision [(b)] shall apply to Department-sponsored examinations administered for the following licenses:

- (i) Electrician (Master/Special)
- (ii) High Pressure Boiler Operating Engineer
- (iii) Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractor (Classes A, B and C)
- (iv) Master Plumber
- (v) Oil Burning Equipment Installer (Classes A and B)
- (vi) Portable High Pressure Boiler Operating Engineer
- (vii) Private Elevator Inspection Agency Director
- (viii) Private Elevator Inspection Agency Inspector
- (ix) Rigger (Master/Special/Climber or Tower Crane)
- (x) Sign Hanger (Master/Special)
- (xi) Site Safety Manager

(2) **Examination procedures.**

- (i) The examination shall consist of a written [and/or a] test, practical test, [and a background investigation of the applicant's character and fitness and training/experience] or a combination of such tests. The practical test may include oral, reading, and/or practical components. Admission to a test does not imply that the applicant possesses the minimum qualifications required. License applicants may not release or otherwise make public the questions and answers for such tests.
- (ii) [Candidates] Applicants must [first] apply for [the written examination] any test by submitting an application on a form prescribed by the Department to the Department's Licensing Unit or its designee. The application must be accompanied by the examination fee and any other required documents as set forth in the Department's rules. Applicants reapplying to take any test, including after a failure, must do so in accordance with the requirements in this paragraph.
- (iii) Where either a written or practical test, but not both, is required, applicants have six (6) months from submission of the application to take the test. Where both written and practical tests are required, applicants have six (6) months from submission of the application to take the written test, two (2) months from notification of passing the written test to submit an application for the practical test, and six (6) months from submission of that application to take the practical test.
- (iv) Failed written test.
 - (A) [Candidates] Applicants who fail the written test must wait at least fourteen (14) days before [retaking it] reapplying to take the test.
 - (B) Each time [a candidate] an applicant wishes to take the written test, including after a failure, the [candidate] applicant must reapply to the Department and pay the required fee as set forth in the Department's rules.
 - (C) [Candidates] Applicants may take the written test no more than three (3) times within a six (6) month period.
 - (D) [Candidates] Applicants who fail the written test three (3) times within six (6) months must wait six (6) months from the date of the third failed written test before [applying again] reapplying to take the written test[, in accordance with the procedure in paragraph (c) of this rule].
- (v) Failed practical test.
 - (A) Applicants who fail the practical test must wait at least ninety (90) days before reapplying to take the test.
 - (B) Each time an applicant wishes to take the practical test, including after a failure, the applicant must reapply to the Department and pay the required fee as set forth in

the Department's rules.

(C) Applicants may take the practical test no more than two (2) times within a twelve (12) month period.

(D) Applicants who fail the practical test two (2) times within twelve (12) months must wait six (6) months from the date of the second failed practical test before reapplying to take the practical test.

[(iv)] (vi) [A candidate] An applicant who has been notified of failure to pass the written or practical test may appeal such failure only if the [candidate] applicant has failed by not more than five (5) points. Such appeal must be in writing with an original signature and addressed as the Commissioner may require. The appeal must state the title of the license examination, the applicant's name, return address and social security number, the date of the test and a detailed statement of the grounds for appeal. The appeal must be received not later than thirty (30) days from the date of notification of failure to pass the [license exam] test.

(vii) Impersonating and cheating.

(A) A person who impersonates another person, allows himself or herself to be impersonated, or otherwise cheats in a license examination shall be disqualified from receiving a license issued by the Department, and may be disqualified from receiving a license issued by another City department or agency and from holding any position with the City of New York.

(B) A person disqualified for impersonating or otherwise cheating may submit a written request to the Commissioner to appeal the disqualification. The written request must set forth reasons to substantiate the request and must be received not later than thirty (30) days from the date of notification of disqualification.

(3) [Issuance of license after examination.

(i) A candidate who passes the required examination as provided in this rule and who is found to have met the qualifications of §28-401.6 of the Administrative Code, after an investigation, shall receive a notice of qualification from the Department.

(ii) Upon receipt of the notice of qualification, the applicant must contact the Department's Licensing Unit to schedule an appointment to obtain the license.

(iii) The applicant shall appear and furnish to the Department all requested original forms, documents and fees within one (1) year of the date of the Department's notice of qualification. Failure to do so within the time specified will result in the denial of the license and will require a re-examination and reapplication.

(iv) License examinations administered by other agencies. License examinations administered by other agencies for licenses regulated by the Department shall continue to be subject to such other agency's rules and regulations regarding examinations and investigations until the responsibility for administering particular licensing examinations is transferred to the Department, at which point the provisions of this rule shall apply.

[(c)] (d) Education, training and experience.

An applicant must possess the minimum education, training and/or experience [requirements specified] required by the Administrative Code at the time of filing the application. For purposes of this subdivision [(c)], the term "experience" refers to that experience gained in the relevant trade as the result of full-time compensated employment, unless otherwise determined by the Commissioner. An applicant shall verify the claimed experience by submitting documentation[, including, but not limited to,] with the application, unless the applicant is required to pass an examination in which case the documentation shall be submitted upon passage of such examination. Such documentation shall include but not be limited to the following:

- (1) Notarized affidavits from all past or current employers under whom experience is claimed. Affidavits from New York City licensees shall be sealed where applicable. Affidavits shall include the following information:
 - (i) Applicant's job title (helper, journeyman, etc.);
 - (ii) A detailed description of applicant's duties;
 - (iii) When applicant worked with the licensee (employment dates shall be in mm/dd/yyyy format);
 - (iv) Whether employment was on a full or part-time basis, detailing the average weekly hours; and
 - (v) Where license supervision is required, a statement by the licensee that he or she directly supervised applicant's work.
- (2) Social Security History of Earnings for the years applicant is claiming as experience reflecting wages appropriate for the trade.
- (3) Where the code requires supervision in the design and installation of plumbing or fire suppression systems, evidence that the supervising licensees performed such

work as demonstrated by permits, completed contracts or such other documentation as the Department may require.

- (4) Where the applicant is self-employed, the applicant shall verify that he or she performed qualifying work by submitting documentation, including but not limited to personal and business tax returns, route sheets or work logs from the supervising licensee, contracts with customers, and statements from customers detailing the work the applicant performed and when that work was performed.
- (5) Where the applicant did not receive monetary compensation from his or her employer as evidenced by payroll records, such as social security payments, income tax withholding or the disbursement of other funds as required by law for the benefit of such employee, the Department may consider such experience if the applicant can provide evidence of an employer-employee relationship. The applicant must provide a detailed explanation of the nature of the employer-employee relationship, which may include, but is not limited to, written agreements between the applicant and the employer, the employer's workers compensation records, time-keeping records, work logs, or other contemporaneous documentation as the Department may require.

[(d)] (e) Investigation.

- (1) The Department or its designee shall conduct an investigation of each [candidate] applicant to determine the [candidate's] applicant's fitness and qualification for the license. The burden of proving that an applicant meets the required qualifications is on the applicant. An applicant's failure to meet the requirements specified by the Administrative Code or by the Department's rules, and/or an applicant's refusal to cooperate with an investigation, will result in denial of the license or certificate of competence.
- (2) [Candidates] Applicants who refuse to provide all requested documents within six (6) months of the date of request shall be denied a license or certificate of competence.
- (3) [A candidate] An applicant who has been notified of failure to meet the fitness and qualification requirements and who has additional relevant information or documentation for the Department's review shall request reconsideration. Such appeal shall be in writing with an original signature and addressed as the Commissioner may require. The request for reconsideration shall state the title of the license examination, the applicant's name and return address, the date of the Department's denial and a detailed statement of the grounds for reconsideration with any supporting documentation. The request for reconsideration shall be received not later than sixty (60) days from the date of notification of the denial of the license.

(f) Issuance of license after approval.

- (1) An applicant who passes an examination required pursuant to this rule, is found to have met the qualifications of §28-401.6 of the Administrative Code, and has been investigated by the Department or its designee, shall receive a notice of approval from the Department.
- (2) Upon receipt of the notice of approval, the applicant must contact the Department's Licensing Unit to schedule an appointment to obtain the license.
- (3) The applicant must appear and furnish to the Department all requested original forms, documents, and fees within one (1) year of the date of the Department's notice of approval. Failure to do so within the time specified will result in the denial of license issuance and will require a re-examination and reapplication.

[(e)] (g) Change of address.

- (1) [Candidates] Applicants shall promptly notify the Department in writing of any address change that occurs after filing the license application.
- (2) Failure to furnish such notification may result in denial of the license and the loss of the opportunity to complete subsequent portions of the license examination, including any tests or investigation.

§ 3. Subdivision b of section 104-02 of title 1 of the rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(b) Commercial general liability insurance.

- (1) Each applicant for and holder of a license shall, at its expense, procure and maintain commercial general liability (CGL) insurance [satisfying] covering the types and scope of work performed under the license, which satisfies the requirements of this subdivision. All CGL insurance policies shall:
 - (i) Be issued by a company or companies that may lawfully issue the required policy and has an A.M. Best rating of at least A-VII or a Standard and Poor's rating of at least A;

- (ii) Provide coverage at least as broad as set forth in the most recent edition of Insurance Services Office (ISO) Form CG 0001; and
- (iii) Provide coverage of at least \$1,000,000 (one million dollars) combined single limit per occurrence [; and].
- (iv) Contain the following endorsement: This policy shall not be cancelled or terminated, or modified or changed unless thirty (30) days' prior written notice is sent to the Named Insured and the New York City Department of Buildings, Licensing Unit, 280 Broadway, 6th Floor, New York, NY 10007, except that termination for non-payment may be made on only ten (10) days' written notice.]
- (2) Each applicant for and holder of a license shall provide proof of CGL insurance by submission of a certificate of insurance in a form satisfactory to the Department that:
- (i) satisfies the requirements of subdivision (e) of this section;
- (ii) identifies the insurance company that issued such insurance policy, the policy number, limit(s) of insurance, and expiration date; and
- (iii) is accompanied by a sworn statement in a form prescribed by the Department from a licensed insurance broker certifying that the insurance certificate may be relied upon as accurate in all respects and that the insurance certificate thereon is in force.
- (3) Any holder of a license who, during the term of the license, is issued any permit of the types set forth in Administrative Code §28-105.2 shall cause the City, together with its officials and employees, to be named as an additional insured on the insurance required under this subdivision with regard to all [operations] work to be performed pursuant to all such permits. The City's coverage shall be at least as broad as set forth in the most recent edition of ISO Form CG 2012 or CG 2026.

What authorizes the Commission to make this rule? Sections 1043 and 2303 of the City Charter and section 19-503 of the City

Administrative Code authorize the Commission to make this proposed rule. This proposed rule was not included in the Commission's regulatory agenda for this Fiscal Year because it was not contemplated when the Commission published the agenda.

Where can I find the Commission's rules? The Commission's rules are in title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What rules govern the rulemaking process? The Commission must meet the requirements of Section 1043 of the City Charter when creating or changing rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of Section 1043(b) of the City Charter.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rules

On February 23, 2012, the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission ("TLC") issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to identify a vendor to provide training, testing, and business education services to current license holders and new applicants seeking to obtain a license to operate a vehicle licensed by the TLC to provide for-hire transportation. The RFP is part of a continuous effort to provide a better customer experience for passengers and to consolidate and improve the TLC's driver education program.

Prior to the RFP, for a driver to obtain a TLC license, he or she was required to attend and pass a series of approved courses offered by different vendors. To ensure consistency in driver training and that all drivers receive the same information, the RFP created a comprehensive curriculum that will be administered by only one vendor.

These proposed rules amend the rules governing driver education requirements to reflect the terms of the contract and the goals of the RFP. Specifically the proposed rules:

- Add a definition of "Authorized Driver Education Services Provider".
- Amend the rules to clarify that all courses drivers can or must take must be taken from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider.
- Reduce the minimum number of hours required for training to reflect the actual number of training hours provided in practice to cover the required curriculum.
- Require all applicants for a Taxicab Driver's renewal license to take a License Renewal Course.
- Require all new Taxicab Driver's license applicants to take a Wheelchair Passenger Assistance Training Course.
- Require all new and renewal Commuter Van and Paratransit Driver's license applicants to take a Defensive Driving Course
- Eliminate the required remedial course for persistent violators, as all drivers, not just persistent violators, will be required to take refresher courses at frequent intervals.
- Clarify the time at which Critical Driver points are assessed.

These rules are authorized by Section 2303 of the Charter and Sections 19-503 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York.

New material is underlined.

[Deleted material is in brackets.]

Section 1. The definitions of the terms "Authorized Taxicab Training," "Authorized Taxicab Training Refresher Course," "Defensive Driving Course," and "Distracted Driving Course" as set forth in section 51-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are amended, and a new definition of the term "Authorized Driver Education Services Provider" is added, in alphabetical order, to read as follows:

[Approved Motor Vehicle Accident Prevention Program is an accident prevention course approved by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles.]

Authorized Driver Education Services Provider refers to the entity which, under contract with the Commission, will provide all courses and exams required by these Rules.

Authorized Taxicab Training refers to a course of training [approved] authorized by the Commission that contains at least [80] 40 hours of instruction on Commission-required topics such as Commission rules and procedures, geography, map reading, Passenger relations, and courtesies.

Authorized [Taxicab Training Refresher] License Renewal Course refers to a [four-hour] course of training [approved] authorized by the Commission that is required for renewal of a [Probationary] Taxicab Driver's License, and that includes topics such as an update of Rule changes, a review of Driver Responsibilities and duties, passenger relations, and an awareness of serving passengers with disabilities.

Defensive Driving Course refers to a course in defensive driving [given by a school, facility or agency approved by the Commission] offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider and [certified] approved by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles.

Distracted Driving Course means a course of training [approved] authorized by the Commission about the dangers of driving while distracted by Using an Electronic Communication Device and about

the rules governing the Using of an Electronic Communication Device. [The course must last at least one hour.]

Section 2. Paragraphs (3), (4), and (7) of subdivision (c) of section 54-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are DELETED and paragraphs (5), (6), and (8) through (19) are renumbered (3), (4), and (5) through (16).

Section 3. Subdivision (k) of section 54-04 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(k) *Training.* The Commission requires that Applicants for a new License pass all prescribed tests, both oral and written, as administered by the Commission or at its direction. All Applicants filing an application on or after a date to be set by the Commission must take the courses listed in paragraphs (1) through (3) below from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider.

* * *

(3) [*Authorized Taxicab Training Refresher Course.* During the last 60 days of the initial one-year Probationary term, Probationary Licensees must attend and pass an Authorized Taxicab Training Refresher course in order to qualify for a renewal License.] *Authorized License Renewal Course.* A Taxicab Driver's License Renewal Applicant must complete the Authorized License Renewal Course within the 60 days prior to the expiration of his/her Taxicab Driver's License expiration.

Section 4. Subdivisions (l), (m), and (n) of section 54-04 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are amended to read as follows:

(l) *Training Providers.* [Providers of Authorized Taxicab Training and Refresher Training services] The Authorized Driver Education Services Provider must be [approved] authorized by the Commission, must administer the curriculum required by the Commission, and must have Commission approval of all fees charged to Taxicab Drivers License Applicants.

(m) *Continuing Training Requirements.* All renewal Applicants are required to attend and complete an authorized Defensive Driving Course [at least every three years. No Taxicab Driver's License will be renewed unless the Applicant submits a certificate of completion of the Defensive Driving Course from an authorized provider dated less than three years prior to the date of the renewal application] and submit a Certificate of Completion dated less than three years prior to the date of the renewal application.

(n) *Wheelchair Passenger Assistance Training.*

(1) *Training Must be [Approved] Authorized by Commission.* In order to become a driver of an Accessible Taxicab or an Accessible Street Hail Livery, a Driver must attend a [Commission-approved] training course provided by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider regarding Wheelchair Passenger assistance (Note: this requirement does not apply to a Paratransit Driver operating an Accessible Street Hail Livery).

(2) *Requirements of the Course.* Wheelchair Passenger assistance training must be a minimum of three hours and must include the following:

* * *

(v) Training on the devices used by the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher to ensure efficient service to the customer.

Section 5. Subdivision (f) of section 54-07 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(f) [*Refresher Training Course*] *License Renewal Course Fees.* Participants of an Authorized Taxicab [Training Refresher] License Renewal Course must pay the fee charged by the [authorized provider] Authorized Driver Education Services Provider.

Section 6. The penalty for violation of paragraph (1) of subdivision (e) of section 54-14 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(e) *Use of Electronic Communication Device.*

(1) A Driver must not Use an Electronic Communication Device while operating a Vehicle. A Driver can Use an Electronic Communication Device only while the Vehicle is lawfully standing or parked.

§54-14(e)(1)	Fine: \$250 if plead guilty before a hearing; \$350 if found guilty following a hearing, and suspension. The suspension is deferred for 60 days; if the driver completes an <u>authorized</u> Distracted Driving Course within the 60-day period then the driver will not be suspended. In order for the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course to reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points and avoid suspension or revocation of the Driver's Taxicab Driver's License, the course must be satisfactorily completed prior to the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons. Completion of the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course after the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons will reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points only after the Licensee completes his or her suspension. If the Licensee's driver's license was issued by a state other than New York, the Licensee must submit a recent driving abstract from the state of licensure.

Section 8. Paragraph (1) of subdivision (b) of section 54-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York, relating to the Required Remedial Course for Persistent Violators is DELETED and paragraphs (2) through (8) of subdivision (b) of section 54-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are renumbered (1) through (7).

Section 9. Paragraph (5) of subdivision (b) of section 54-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(5) *Point Reduction for Voluntary Course Completion.*

(i) Before suspending or revoking a Driver's License, the Commission will deduct two points from the total points of any Licensee who voluntarily attends and satisfactorily completes a remedial or refresher course [approved by the Commission] offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider.

Section 10. Subdivision (f) of section 55-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is DELETED and subdivisions (g) through (v) are relettered (f) through (u).

Section 11. Paragraphs (4), (5), and (7) of subdivision (a) of section 55-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are amended to read as follows:

(4) *15-Month Period.* When determining whether a suspension or revocation is required based on the accumulation of points in a 15-month period, the Commission will count backwards 15 months from the date of the most recent [violation] conviction carrying points that is cited in the summons under this section.

(5) *Date of Point Accumulation.* For the purpose of this rule,

points assigned by the Department of Motor Vehicles for any violation will be counted as of the date of the conviction on the violation [occurred].

(7) *Point Reduction for Voluntary Course Completion.*

- (i) Before suspending or revoking a Driver's License, the Commission will deduct two points from the total points of any Licensee who voluntarily attends and satisfactorily completes a [motor Vehicle accident prevention course approved by the NYS DMV] Defensive Driving Course that appears on the Licensee's DMV driving record. Such point reduction will count only towards points accumulated by the Licensee as a result of [violations] convictions that occurred within 15 months prior to the date of the completion of the course. In order for the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course to reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points and avoid suspension or revocation of the Driver's For-Hire Vehicle Driver's License, the course must be satisfactorily completed prior to the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons. Completion of the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course after the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons will reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points only after the Licensee completes his or her suspension. If the Licensee's driver's license was issued by a state other than New York, the Licensee must submit a recent driving abstract from the state of licensure.

Section 12. Paragraph (1) of subdivision (b) of section 55-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York, relating to the Required Remedial Course for Persistent Violators is DELETED and paragraphs (2) through (8) of subdivision (b) of section 55-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are renumbered (1) through (7).

Section 13. Paragraph (5) of subdivision (b) of section 55-27 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(5) *Point Reduction for Voluntary Course Completion.*

- (ii) Before suspending or revoking a Driver's License, the Commission will deduct two points from the total points of any Licensee who voluntarily attends and satisfactorily completes a remedial or refresher course [approved by the Commission] offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider.

Section 14. Subdivision (c) of section 56-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is DELETED and subdivisions (d) through (j) are relettered (c) through (i).

Section 15. Subdivision (l) of 56-04 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (1) [Reserved. Training.] Defensive Driving Course. Applicants must hold a certificate of completion from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider for the required hours of instruction in a Defensive Driving Course dated within six months prior to the application date.

- (1) All renewal Applicants must submit a certificate of completion from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider of a Defensive Driving Course dated within three years prior to the date of the renewal application.

Section 16. Paragraph (4), (5), and (7) of subdivision (b) of section 56-13 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (4) *15-Month Period.* When determining whether a suspension or revocation is required based on the accumulation of points in a 15-month period, the Commission will count backwards 15 months from the date of the most recent [violation] conviction carrying points that is cited in the summons under this section.
- (5) *Date of Point Accumulation.* For the purpose of this rule, points assigned by the Department of Motor Vehicles for any violation will be counted as of the date of the conviction on the violation [occurred].

* * *

(7) *Point Reduction for Voluntary Course Completion.*

- (i) Before suspending or revoking a Driver's License, the Commission will deduct two points from the total points of any Licensee who voluntarily attends and satisfactorily completes a [motor vehicle accident prevention course approved by the NYS DMV] Defensive Driving Course that appears on the Licensee's DMV driving record. Such point reduction will count only

towards points accumulated by the Licensee as a result of [violations] convictions that occurred within 15 months prior to the date of the completion of the course. In order for the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course to reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points and avoid suspension or revocation of the Driver's Paratransit Driver's License, the course must be satisfactorily completed prior to the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons. Completion of the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course after the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons will reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points only after the Licensee completes his or her suspension. If the Licensee's driver's license was issued by a state other than New York, the Licensee must submit a recent driving abstract from the state of licensure.

Section 17. Paragraph (2) of subdivision (i) of section 56-14 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (2) In addition to the penalties provided above for any violation of this Rule, a Driver convicted of a violation of this Rule must complete a Distracted Driving Course offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider no later than 60 days after the date of conviction. The license of a Driver who does not complete the Distracted Driving Course within the 60 day period will be suspended until compliance. In instances where the Chairperson has not received proof of completion of a Distracted Driving Course from [a Distracted Driving Course provider] the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider, the Chairperson will provide notice to the Driver prior to suspension that the Driver has a specified time of no less than 10 days from the date of the notice to provide proof of completion of a Distracted Driving Course to the Chairperson by mail.

Section 18. Subdivision (j) of 57-04 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (j) [Reserved. Training.] Defensive Driving Course. Applicants must hold a certificate of completion from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider for the required hours of instruction in a Defensive Driving Course dated within six months prior to the application date.
- (1) All renewal Applicants must submit a certificate of completion from the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider of a Defensive Driving Course dated within three years prior to the date of the renewal application.

Section 19. Paragraph (7) of subdivision (a) of section 57-13 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (4) *15-Month Period.* When determining whether a suspension or revocation is required based on the accumulation of points in a 15-month period, the Commission will count backwards 15 months from the date of the most recent [violation] conviction carrying points that is cited in the summons under this section.
- (5) *Date of Point Accumulation.* For the purpose of this rule, points assigned by the Department of Motor Vehicles for any violation will be counted as of the date of the conviction on the violation [occurred].

* * *

(7) *Point Reduction for Voluntary Course Completion.*

- (i) Before suspending or revoking a Driver's License, the Commission will deduct two points from the total points of any Driver who voluntarily attends and satisfactorily completes a [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider and approved by the NYS DMV that appears on the Licensee's DMV driving record. Such point reduction will count only towards points accumulated by the Licensee as a result of [violations] convictions that occurred within 15 months prior to the date of the completion of the course. In order for the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course to reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points and avoid suspension or revocation of the Driver's Commuter Van Driver's License, the course must be satisfactorily completed prior to the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons. Completion of the [motor vehicle accident prevention course] Defensive Driving Course after the [issuance of] conviction on a critical driver program summons will reduce the Licensee's Critical Driver's Program points only after the Licensee completes his or her suspension. If the Licensee's

driver's license was issued by a state other than New York, the Licensee must submit a recent driving abstract from the state of licensure.

Section 20. Paragraph (2) of subdivision (b) of section 57-14 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (2) In addition to the penalties provided above for any violation of this Rule, a Driver convicted of a violation of this Rule must complete a Distracted Driving Course offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider, no later than 60 days after the date of conviction. The license of a Driver who does not complete the Distracted Driving Course within the 60 day period will be suspended until compliance. In instances where the Chairperson has not received proof of completion of a Distracted Driving Course from [a Distracted Driving Course provider] the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider, the Chairperson will provide notice to the Driver prior to suspension that the Driver has a specified time of no less than 10 days from the date of the notice to provide proof of completion of a Distracted Driving Course to the Chairperson by mail.

Section 21. Paragraphs (1) and (2) of subdivision (c) of section 58-20 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York are amended to read as follows:

- (c) Wheelchair Passenger Assistance Training.
(1) Training Must be [Approved] Authorized by the Commission. The Owner of an Accessible Taxicab must make sure each Driver of such Accessible Taxicab has attended a [Commission-approved] training course offered by the Authorized Driver Education Services Provider regarding Wheelchair Passenger assistance.
(2) Requirements of the Course. Wheelchair Passenger assistance training must be a minimum of three hours and must include the following:

* * *

- (v) Training on the devices used by the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher, and any other device used to dispatch Accessible Taxis approved by the Commission, to ensure efficient service to the customer.
