Applications by JNB Realty LLC and the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), pursuant to Sections 197-c and 201 of the New York City Charter affecting 10 privately owned lots fronting Autumn, Lincoln, and Wortman Avenues in East New York. The co-applicants are seeking:

 A zoning map amendment to change the development site from R4 to R6A and R6B districts

- A zoning map amendment to designate the development site a Mandatory Inclusionary Housing (MIH) Area
- Acquisition and disposition of four formerly City-Owned lots in the project area by HPD

The requested actions would facilitate two five- and seven-story residential buildings, with a total of 206 affordable apartments on a 50,000-square foot parcel in Brooklyn Community District 16 (CD 16). The units would be geared toward households earning, on average, 30% to 70% of Area Median Income (AMI). Approximately 63 units would be permanently affordable, pursuant to MIH Option 1. The development would provide 55 ground-floor and cellar-level accessory parking spaces. As part of the project, Wortman Avenue will be developed with a new street and sidewalk to allow vehicular and pedestrian traffic.



Pursuant to City Environmental Quality Review (CEQR), Mayoral Executive Order No. 91 of 1977, CEQR Rules of Procedure of 1991 and the regulations of Article 8 of the State Environmental Conservation Law, State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) as found in 6 NYCRR Part 617, a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) has been prepared for the action described below. Copies of the DEIS are available for public inspection at the office of the undersigned as well as online via the 1160 Flushing project page on ZAP: https://aap.planning.nyc.gov/projects/2020K0289. To view the 1160 Flushing DEIS and Appendix, navigate to the project page in ZAP and select Public Documents, then "DEIS_21DCP199K". The proposal involves actions by the City Planning Commission (CPC) and the New York City Council pursuant to Uniform Land Use Review Procedure (ULURP). A public hearing on the DEIS will be held at a later date to be announced, in conjunction with the City Planning Commission's citywide public hearing, pursuant to ULURP. Advance notice will be given of the time and place of the hearing. Written comments on the DEIS are requested and would be received and considered by the Lead Agency until the 10th calendar day following the close of the public hearing.

A. INTRODUCTION

The Applicant (1160 Flushing Avenue LLC) is seeking a zoning map amendment (the "Proposed Action"), that would facilitate the construction of a new, mixed-use development comprising approximately 238,104 gross square feet (gsf) in total (the "Proposed Project"). The Proposed Project would be constructed at 1160 Flushing Avenue (Block 3167, Lots 18 and 24), a 37,928-sf, rectangular-shaped site with frontages on Flushing Avenue and Jefferson Street in the Bushwick neighborhood of Brooklyn Community District (CD) 4 ("Projected Development Site 1").

The Applicant seeks City Planning Commission ("CPC") approval for a zoning map amendment that would rezone Block 3167, Lots 12 (p/o), 18, 24, 26, 29, and 40 (the "Proposed Rezoning Area" or "Project Area") from a M1-1 district to a M1-5 district (the "Proposed Action"). The Proposed Action will undergo coordinated review under City Environmental Quality Review ("CEQR"), with the New York City Department of City Planning (DCP) serving on behalf of the CPC as lead agency.

The Proposed Action would facilitate the demolition of the existing single-story building on Projected Development Site 1 and the construction of the Proposed Project. As stated above, Lots 18 and 24 are owned and controlled by the Applicant and comprise Projected Development Site 1; Lots 12, 26, 29, and 40 are not owned or controlled by the Applicant. The Proposed Project would consist of a single-story building and a nine-story building separated by a pedestrian alleyway. The single-story structure and first two floors and cellar floor of the nine-story building would contain a combined total of approximately 75,586 gsf (36,730 zoning square feet (zsf)) of retail uses (0.97 FAR); the second and third floors of the proposed nine-story building would contain approximately 40,732 gsf (37,846 zsf) of light industrial uses (1.0 FAR); and the remaining floors (three through nine) of the

proposed nine-story building would contain approximately 121,786 gsf (114,983 zsf) of commercial office uses (3.03 FAR). Three loading bays would be provided with a single curb cut along Flushing Avenue to satisfy the M1-5 zoning requirements associated with the proposed office, retail, and light industrial uses; no accessory parking spaces would be required under the proposed M1-5 zoning district. In total, the Proposed Project would contain approximately 238,104 gsf (189,559 zsf) of new development.

In the future with the Proposed Action, it is assumed that the proposed zoning map amendment would be approved, allowing the Applicant to construct the Proposed Project at Projected Development Site 1 (Lots 18 and 24). However, as the proposed M1-5 zoning district permits a maximum floor area ratio (FAR) of 6.5 for community facility uses, the reasonable worst-case development scenario (RWCDS) for Projected Development Site 1 assumes an additional 1.5 FAR of community facility (medical office) uses. As such, for conservative analysis purposes, it is assumed that Projected Development Site 1 could accommodate up to approximately 75,586 gsf (36,730 zsf) of retail uses, approximately 40,732 gsf (37,846 zsf) of light industrial uses, approximately 121,786 (114,983 zsf) of community facility (medical office) uses (the "RWCDS"). In total, the RWCDS for Projected Development Site 1 would comprise approximately 298,077 gsf (246,534 zsf) of new development (6.5 FAR).

In addition, it is assumed that Lots 29 and 40 (both of which are non-Applicant-owned) would each be redeveloped in the future with approval of the Proposed Action as well. It is anticipated that Lot 29 would be redeveloped with a six-story, 5.0 FAR predominantly commercial office building with ground-floor retail uses comprising approximately 79,821 gsf of office space and 16,730 gsf of retail space ("Projected Development Site 2"), and Lot 40 would be redeveloped with a five-story, 5.0 FAR predominantly commercial office building with ground-floor retail uses comprising approximately 32,547 gsf of office space and 6,250 gsf of retail space ("Projected Development Site 3"). As a result, the total With-Action development scenario for the Project Area would include approximately 234,154 gsf of commercial office uses, 98,566 gsf of retail uses, 40,732 gsf of light industrial uses, and 59,973 gsf of community facility (medical office) uses, thus representing the RWCDS for the Project Area under the Proposed Action.

It is expected that all three projected development sites would be constructed and fully operational by the end of 2027. Without discretionary approval, it is anticipated that the on-site conditions would remain unchanged from existing conditions, with exception to Projected Development Site 1 which is expected to be converted and reoccupied with commercial retail uses.

The Proposed Action include:

Zoning Map Amendment

The proposed zoning map amendment, which would rezone the Project Area from M1-1 to M1-5, would increase the maximum permitted FAR from 2.4 to 6.5, allowing for additional development of commercial, light industrial, and/or community facility uses than could be provided under existing conditions, in addition to reducing the loading dock and accessory parking requirements. While the Project Area under an M1-5 district would still be governed by the sky-exposure plane as under the existing M1-1 zoning, the additional permitted density under the M1-5 district would result in larger building envelopes to accommodate the increase in permitted commercial, light industrial, and community facility uses. The Proposed Rezoning Area would be mapped 250 feet north of Irving Avenue between Flushing Avenue and Jefferson Street, and its boundaries would extend approximately 493 feet along Flushing Avenue, 146 feet along Wyckoff Avenue, and 485 feet along Jefferson Street.

In conjunction with the Proposed Action, an E-designation (E-674) will be recorded on Projected Development Sites 1, 2 and 3 (Block 3167, Lots 18, 24, 29 and 40) to preclude significant adverse impacts related to air quality, noise and hazardous materials. In addition, a Restrictive Declaration will be recorded to codify commitments made in the EIS related to the environmental review.

B. ANALYSIS FRAMEWORK FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW Reasonable Worst-Case Development Scenario (RWCDS)

In order to assess the possible effects of the Proposed Action, a RWCDS for the Project Area was established for both Future No-Action and Future With-Action conditions by the build year of 2027. The incremental difference between the Future No-Action and Future With-Action conditions will serve as the basis of the impact category analyses. For reasonable worst-case analysis purposes, it is assumed that Projected Development Site 1 would accommodate approximately 75,586 gsf (36,730 zsf) of retail uses, approximately 40,732 gsf (37,846 zsf) of light industrial uses, approximately 121,786 gsf (114,983 zsf) of commercial office uses, and approximately 59,973 gsf (56,975 zsf) of community facility (medical office) uses (the "RWCDS"). Similar to the Proposed Project, the RWCDS would require three loading bays, which would be accommodated by a single curb cut along Flushing Avenue,

and would not contain any accessory parking spaces. In total, the RWCDS for Projected Development Site 1 would contain approximately 298,077 gsf (246,534 zsf) of new development (6.5 FAR).

In addition, it is assumed that Projected Development Site 2 (Lot 29) and Projected Development Site 3 (Lot 40) would each be redeveloped in the 2027 With-Action scenario. It is anticipated that Projected Development Site 2 would be redeveloped with a six-story, 5.0 FAR predominantly commercial office building with ground-floor retail uses comprising approximately 79,821 gsf of office space and 16,730 gsf of retail space, and Projected Development Site 3 would be redeveloped with a five-story, 5.0 FAR predominantly commercial office building with ground-floor retail uses comprising approximately 32,547 gsf of office space and 6,250 gsf of retail space.

In total, the With-Action development scenario for the Project Area (including the would include approximately 234,154 gsf of commercial office uses, 98,566 gsf of retail uses, 40,732 gsf of light industrial uses, and 59,973 gsf of community facility (medical office) uses, thus representing the RWCDS for the Project Area under the Proposed Action

The DEIS assesses whether development resulting from the Proposed Action could result in significant adverse environmental impacts. The DEIS identifies potential significant adverse impacts to transportation (traffic and pedestrians). Potential mitigation measures for these technical areas are identified below.

$\begin{array}{c} {\bf Transportation} \\ {\bf \textit{Traffic}} \end{array}$

The Proposed Action would result in significant adverse impacts at seven study area intersections during one or more analyzed peak hours during the weekday A.M., weekday midday, weekday P.M., and Saturday midday peak hours. Implementation of traffic engineering improvements, such as signal timing changes would provide mitigation for several of the anticipated traffic impacts. Implementation of the recommended traffic engineering improvements is subject to review and approval by the New York City DOT and will be further refined between the DEIS and FEIS. If, prior to implementation, DOT determines that an identified mitigation measure is infeasible, an alternative mitigation measure will be identified, if possible. In the absence of the application of mitigation measures, the impacts would remain unmitigated.

The types of mitigation measures proposed herein are standard measures that are routinely identified by the City and considered feasible for implementation. Implementation of the recommended traffic engineering improvements is subject to review and approval by DOT. In the absence of the application of mitigation measures, the impacts would remain unmitigated.

Assuming all the proposed mitigation measures were implemented, significant adverse impacts would be fully mitigated at two lane groups in the weekday A.M. peak hour, one lane group in the midday peak hour, two lane groups in the weekday P.M. peak hour, and one lane group in the Saturday peak hour. Impacts would be fully mitigated at one intersection during the weekday A.M., P.M., and Saturday peak hours. During the weekday midday peak hour, none of the impacted intersections would be fully mitigated. In total, impacts to one or more lane groups would remain unmitigated in one or more peak hours at seven intersections.

Proposed Schedule for Traffic Mitigation Measures

In order to determine whether the implementation of some or all of the traffic mitigation measures would be warranted in 2025 and/or 2027, the Applicant will commit, in consultation with DOT and DCP, to undertake a transportation monitoring program (TMP). The focus of this TMP will be explored further by the Applicant in consultation with DOT and DCP between DEIS and FEIS. A report summarizing the findings of the TMP would be submitted to DOT and DCP along with relevant backup data. The TMP scope of work for would be submitted for DOT and DCP review and approval prior to implementation. The Applicant would be responsible for all costs associated with the TMP and any proposed traffic improvement/mitigation measures, and would submit all required drawings for such measures to DOT for review and approval.

Pedestrians

Incremental demand from the Proposed Action would result in significant adverse impacts to one crosswalk in one or more peak hours. There would be no significant adverse impacts to analyzed sidewalks and corner areas in any period. Widening the impacted crosswalk by 4.5 feet would fully mitigate the significant crosswalk impacts. Implementation of the proposed mitigation measures would be subject to review and approval by DOT. If, prior to implementation, DOT determines that an identified mitigation measure is infeasible, an alternative mitigation measure will be identified, if possible. In the absence of the application of mitigation measures, the impacts would remain unmitigated.

Additionally, proposed traffic mitigation measures (discussed previously) would potentially affect pedestrian conditions at a total of two corners and two crosswalks in one or more peak hours. The recommended traffic mitigation measure at Flushing Avenue and Wyckoff Avenue would consist of signal timing adjustments to transfer green time from the northbound phase to the eastbound/westbound phase in each analyzed peak hour.

With the implementation of the proposed signal timing adjustment at the Flushing Avenue and Wyckoff Avenue intersection, the south and west crosswalk would continue to operate at LOS C or better during each analyzed peak hour. In addition, the southeast and southwest corners at the Flushing Avenue and Wyckoff Avenue intersection would continue to operate at LOS B or better during each analyzed peak hour with the implementation of the proposed traffic mitigation.

The DEIS considers two alternatives — a No-Action Alternative and a No Unmitigated Significant Adverse Impact Alternative. The No-Action Alternative examines future conditions within the Project Area, but assumes the absence of the Proposed Actions (i.e., none of the discretionary approvals proposed as part of the Proposed Actions would be adopted). The No Unmitigated Significant Adverse Impacts Alternative examines a scenario in which the Proposed Actions are changed specifically to avoid the unmitigated significant adverse impacts associated with the Proposed Actions.
