BIC and DCAS Partner With US DOT Volpe on Safe Fleet Plan

This week, the Business Integrity Commission (BIC) and the Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS) released a [Safe Fleet Transition Plan \(SFTP\)](#) focusing on safety for commercial waste vehicles and garbage trucks. The SFTP was produced in partnership with the U.S. DOT Volpe Center. The [press release](#) is available on DCAS's website.

This is the fourth Safe Fleet Transition Plan (SFTP) published by DCAS and Volpe. In 2015, DCAS and Volpe published a [report on truck side-guards](#) that has since led to two separate local laws. In 2017, DCAS published [the first SFTP for the City's fleet](#), which now serves as a guide for the City's new vehicle acquisition policy. Most recently, in 2018, an [updated Safe Fleet Transition Plan for the City fleet](#) was published.

The commercial waste fleet report was the first published in compliance with [Mayoral Executive Order 53 of 2020](#), which calls for DCAS to prepare regular Safe and Clean Fleet Transition Plans aimed at private and public fleets and in support of a *Fleets of the Future Initiative*. DCAS and Volpe completed a five-year extension of their partnership in September 2021.

For this report, Volpe studied a decade of actual NYC crashes involving commercial waste vehicles, from January 2010 through May 2019. Volpe categorized the causes of the crashes and the types of vehicles involved. Using these results, Volpe, BIC, and DCAS identified the most impactful potential steps for improving fleet design and reducing crashes.

The main recommendations include:

- Transition to high vision trucks, to address line of sight restrictions.

- Fully implement the truck side-guard program.
- Specify new vehicles and retrofit existing trucks with additional safety devices, including surround cameras and additional mirrors.
- Avoid devices, like bug deflectors, that can impair a driver's vision.

Noah D. Genel, Commissioner and Chair of the New York City Business Integrity Commission on the release of this report said, "Improving traffic safety in the commercial waste-hauling industry is an important goal of BIC's, and the guidance provided by this preliminary report has been crucial in furthering that goal."

BIC and DCAS will work together to distribute and discuss this report with the commercial waste industry and promote the implementation of these and other safety steps.

Many thanks to everyone at BIC, DCAS, U.S. DOT Volpe, and the Mayor's Office for their support and work on this initiative.
