## Per Safety Requirement for City Contractors NYC Mayoral Executive Order 39 of 2024

	<b>Vehicle List:</b> List of City-contracted vehicles, including the year, make, model, VIN and license plate per of each City-contracted vehicle.
each licens	<b>Drivers List</b> : List of driver names, license types including required endorsements, and affirmation that driver has been enrolled in the New York State License Notification System (LENS) or that out of state sees are being monitored. Contractor must notify contracting agency of any license suspensions and/or ts tied to unsafe or illegal vehicle operation by drivers of City-contracted vehicles.
trainir a Nev contra regist	<b>Safety Training</b> : Documentation showing that all drivers of City-contracted vehicles have completed the ng satisfactory for the contracting agency, showing 1) that all drivers of City-contracted vehicles have taken w York State-approved defensive driving class within six months after registration, 2) that all drivers of City-acted vehicles have attended a New York State-approved defensive driving class within 3 years prior to tration, or 3) that all drivers of City-contracted vehicles have received alternative safe driver training otable to the contracting agency that is documented to the satisfaction of the contracting agency.
	<b>Crash Tracking:</b> An explanation of contractor's process of monitoring and reviewing collisions including to notify contracting agency of collisions that take place while performing services under the contract.
	<b>Corrective Action:</b> A corrective action program for drivers of City-contracted vehicles that engage in fe or dangerous driving behaviors and license monitoring.

truck and D	<b>Truck Side-Guards:</b> Contractor's indication of which trucks are subject to Local Law 108 of 2021 requiring side-guards and plans to comply with the Local Law. Contractor must confirm to the contracting agency DCAS that side-guards have been installed as required by the Local Law and the public rules for Local Law mplementation.
desig truck to the	High Vision Trucks and/or Truck Surround Cameras: Contractor's indication of which trucks are need as high vision trucks in accordance with the Executive Order. For all others, contractor's plan to install surround cameras in compliance with the timetables set out in the Executive Order. Contractor must submit a contracting agency photographic and purchase order evidence, that is satisfactory to the contracting cy, of compliance with high vision and truck surround camera requirements.
servi	<b>Telematics:</b> Contractor's confirmation that all vehicles used for the performance of City contracted ces are installed with telematics that track at minimum location and speed. Data gathered by telematics be made available in a manner that is satisfactory to the contracting agency.
