# WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES:

Computer Specialists (Software) under supervision, with considerable latitude for independent action or the exercise of independent judgment, are responsible for the analysis, design, development, implementation, enhancement, maintenance and security of database management systems, operating systems, data communications systems, applications, mobile applications, websites, and/or related software functions. Computer Specialists (Software) may also have specialized responsibilities, including but not limited to managing Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) systems and large-scale database projects and responding with on-call, emergency support for critical systems. Computer Specialists (Software) may supervise a unit engaged in work related to these areas or may independently perform related work of a highly complex, technical nature. All Computer Specialists (Software) perform related work.

# Special Working Conditions:

Computer Specialists (Software) may be required to work various shifts including nights, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

# THE SALARY:

The current minimum salary is \$92,236 per annum. This rate is subject to change. There are four assignment levels within this class of positions. Appointments will generally be made to Assignment Level I. After appointment, employees may be assigned to the higher assignment levels at the discretion of the agency.

#### HOW TO QUALIFY:

You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the education and experience requirements for this examination prior to submitting your application. If you are found "Not Qualified," your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

As per section 54(2) of the Civil Service Law, the education requirement needed to qualify must be met by January 28, 2026. The experience requirement needed to qualify must be met by the last day of the Application Period (January 28, 2025).

# EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university, including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in computer science or a related computer field **and** two years of satisfactory, full-time computer software experience in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, maintenance and support, systems programming, data communications, mainframe development, mobile development and/or web development and design, one year of which must have been in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project in one or more of the acceptable areas; or

- 2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent **and** six years of satisfactory, full-time computer software experience as described in "1" above, **one year of which must have been in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project in one or more of the acceptable areas; or**
- 3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that 60 semester credits from an accredited college or university is equated to one year of experience. A master's degree from an accredited college or university in computer science or a related computer field, or a certificate of at least 625 hours in computer programming from an accredited technical school (post high school), may be substituted for one year of the required experience in "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four- year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project in one or more of the acceptable areas.

Note: Some examples of unacceptable experience are:

- a. end users of: a computer system, program or software package; productivity software products (e.g., word processing, spreadsheet, presentation, and database software, etc.); preprogrammed software without complex programming, design and implementation.
- b. experience in the areas of: computer technical support, computer operations, data entry/data retrieval, hardware installation, call center, teaching and/or telecommunications.

# In order to have your experience as a Project Leader or Major Contributor on a complex project accepted, you must have dedicated at least 50% of your time performing duties involving computer software in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, maintenance and support, systems programming, data communications, mainframe development, mobile development and/or web development and design.

The high school diploma or its educational equivalent must be approved by a State's Department of Education or a recognized accrediting organization. The technical school (post high school) must be approved by a State's Department of Education or a recognized accrediting organization. The college or university must be accredited by regional, national, professional, or specialized agencies recognized as accrediting bodies by the U.S. Secretary of Education and by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA).

If you were educated outside the United States, you must have your foreign education evaluated to determine its equivalence to education obtained in the United States. This is required <u>only</u> if you need credit for your foreign education in this examination. For more information see the Foreign Education Evaluation Guide in the Required Information section.

During the Education and Experience Exam (EEE), you may answer questions about your experience. #### THE TEST RESULTS:

If you pass the Education and Experience Exam, your name will be placed in final score order on eligible list, you will be given a list number, and you will be notified by email of your test results. The eligible list determines the order by which candidates will be considered for appointment. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for appointment if your name is reached on the eligible list. Once a list has been established, it will typically remain active for four years. Experience must include a combination of implementing data storage solutions, managing and developing data processing, monitoring and optimizing data solutions. Experience must also include designing Azure; data storage solutions, processing solutions, and data security and compliance solutions
- 5. Backup Administration (119): A valid industrial certified Backup and Recovery Specialist and/or at least two (2) years of full-time satisfactory experience as an administrator of a large-scale backup software product such as NetBackup, Commvault, Veeam, Cohesity, Rubrik, Data Protection Suite, Networker, TSM, Simpana, Data Protector or Avamar, or two (2) years as a backup administrator with the remaining time spent administering either SAN storage, a virtualization hypervisor platform, or both

Business Analysis (BNA): At least two (2) years of satisfactory, full-time experience employing User-Centered Analysis techniques (interviews, direct observations, requirement work sessions, etc.) in a variety of software development life cycle (SDLC) methodologies, including Agile methodologies
- (e.g., Scrum, Kanban, Scrumban, etc.), with experience including eliciting business needs and defining requirements packages for IT applications.

CRM Systems Administration (233): At least five (5) years of satisfactory, full-time experience in administering, designing, developing, implementing, maintaining and/or enhancing industry leading CRM Systems and its related platforms. Examples include, but are not limited to: Oracle Siebel, Microsoft Dynamics, Oracle CRM, Salesforce, Actuate and/or BI Publisher, Visual Studio, IIS, SQL Server, SSRS, XML/XSL/Web Services with strong knowledge of Unix, Linux and SQL or related technology
- CyberSecurity (221): A minimum of two (2) years of satisfactory, full-time professional experience in the field of Cybersecurity technology. This experience should demonstrate proficiency in implementing and maintaining cybersecurity protocols, conducting risk assessments, and managing security incidents. Candidates should possess a comprehensive understanding of cybersecurity principles provide the planting of the provention of the provention. principles, practices, and technologies, and have a proven track record of effectively safeguarding information systems and networks

Data Engineering (DEN): At least two (2) years of satisfactory, full-time experience in the design, development, implementation, maintenance and enhancement of application and data pipeline development, Implementation, maintenance and ennancement of application and data pipeline integrations using cloud, database, programming and ETL/ELT technologies.
