DEP Police force protects the water supply system for the City of New York, including the water sources, the associated critical infrastructure and personnel from natural and manmade hazards like terrorism, pollution and crime.

DEP Police patrols and secures the New York City's **2,000** square miles of watershed area, **40,000** plus acres of New York City owned lands, and infrastructure on patrol and on foot with the assistance of specialized equipment such as UTV's, boats, airboats, bicycles, helicopters, and snowmobiles - 24 hours, 7 days a week.





The Opportunity

New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is the largest municipal water utility in North America, with more than 6,000 employees. Every day, DEP delivers more than 1.1 billion gallons of water to nine million New Yorkers, and treats more than 1.3 billion gallons of wastewater.

The DEP Police force was created in 1907 to patrol the watershed lands owned by DEP that supply drinking water to the citizens of New York City. For over a century, DEP Police Force patrols almost 200,000 acres of watershed lands for the City of New York.

Enforcement

DEP officers respond to alarms, suspicious person calls, trespassers, etc. They also conduct preliminary environmental investigations.

Our Police Force operates specialized equipment consisting of Personal Radiation Detectors (PRD), chlorine meters, night vision and thermo imaging devices, explosive detectors, and much more.
