RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the reconstruction of the plaza east of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Monument, including the installation of an ADA path, West 88th Street and Riverside Drive, Riverside Park, Manhattan, submitted by the Department of Parks & Recreation, represented by exhibits 2287-LZ, MA & MB of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that the team will (1) clarify the plan for the temporary ADA-access to the tower interior during planned public events and (2) study the geometry of the garden path in relationship to the existing axial and traditional geometry of the monument.

Preliminary approval is conditioned upon submission of this project for final review and approval before July 15, 2026
