Travel Request helps individuals and families make the transition from crisis to independence.

If you are a single adult or part of a family applying for shelter or are in the shelter system, and you have a housing option outside of New York City, Travel Request may be able to help you by providing one-way travel assistance by train, bus or domestic or international airline if you qualify.

You can qualify for Travel Request travel assistance if you have:



A strong connection to a location outside of New York City



Already identified an apartment or house where you can live
