



Citywide Immunization Registry Pharmacy Aggregate Reporting

Standing Orders Aggregate Form

Pharmacies participating in the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYC Health Department) Standing Order program are required to report aggregate vaccine doses administered to the Online Registry within the Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR) every month.

- 1. Log in to the Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR)'s <u>Online Registry</u> and click VIM/COVID in the menu bar.
- 2. Click on the tab labeled Standing Orders Aggregate Form.
- 3. Select the Reporting Month (the month you are submitting for, not the month you are submitting in) and then click **Continue**.



4. Submit a record of vaccinations administered under the NYC Health Department standing order. If there were no vaccinations administered for the month, enter zero doses.

If you attempt to enter data for a month for which immunizations were already submitted, a message indicating the date and time of previous submission will be listed at the top of the page:

Standing Orders Report

Pharmacists can also pull reports that compare the number of doses submitted via the **Standing Orders Aggregate Form** to the number of patient-level doses reported during the same time period using the **Standing Orders Report**.

- 1. Log in to the Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR)'s <u>Online Registry</u> and click VIM/COVID in the menu bar.
- 2. Click on the tab labeled **Reports**.
- 3. Select the tab labeled **Standing Orders Report.**
- 4. Select the **date** range for the report and click **Continue**.



5. View **Standing Orders Report**. A printer-friendly format of the report is available. This report does not need to be submitted.
