FAQs

How can I know if a product contains lead, mercury, or arsenic?

It can be difficult to tell the difference between safe and dangerous products. Lead, mercury, or arsenic may be present in supplements or remedies even if they are not listed as an ingredient on the product label.

How does lead, mercury, or arsenic get into these products?

Lead, mercury, or arsenic may be intentionally added to some products for perceived therapeutic benefits or unintentionally added during manufacturing.

How can lead, mercury, and arsenic affect my health?

Using supplements or remedies with high levels of lead, mercury, or arsenic can cause health problems. Exposure to these metals can damage the brain, kidneys, nervous, and reproductive systems. The higher the amount of metal present in a product and the more frequently the product is used, the higher the risk for harmful health effects. People who regularly use products found to contain high levels of metals are especially at risk.

- What should I do if I use remedies or supplements that may contain lead, mercury, or arsenic?
 - Immediately stop using products found to contain high levels of these metals.
 - Ask your doctor to test you for lead and other heavy metals. If you do not have a doctor, call 311 for help.
- What should business owners do if they sell supplements or remedies found to contain lead, mercury, or arsenic?
 - Immediately stop selling and remove such products from store shelves and inventory.
 - Call **311** to provide the health department with information on product suppliers.
