#### 1 PROCEEDINGS 2 MS. LIPMAN: Good morning and welcome. My name is Rebecca Lipman. I 3 4 am an attorney in the Bureau of Legal 5 Affairs for the Department of Sanitation. 6 7 Thank you for attending the public hearing this morning. 8 9 DSNY is conducting this remote 10 hearing in accordance with the 11 requirements of the City Administrative 12 Procedure Act. 13 The purpose of this hearing is to 14 receive comments from the public on 15 DSNY's proposed rule relating to the level of service commercial waste zone 16 17 awardees must provide to assigned 18 customers. 19 This rule was published by DSNY in 20 The City Record on November 27, 2024 21 with a scheduled hearing date of today, December 27, 2024. 22 Additionally, DSNY emailed copies of 23 the rule to all New York City 24 25 local-elected officials, the City's 59

community boards, media, and interested parties, and published the rule on its website.

The Department of Sanitation is currently implementing the first zone of the Commercial Waste Zones program mandated by Local Law 199 of 2019.

The private waste carters who have been awarded the right to operate within the first zone ("awardees") have been signing up customers, but the percentage of businesses that have signed up with an awardee remains low.

Pursuant to 16 RCNY 20-20(e), the Department will assign an awardee to any businesses that have failed to sign-up with an awardee by the final implementation date for the zone.

The rules of the Department currently state that assigned businesses shall receive two days a week of refuse collection and one day of designated recyclable materials collection per week, as well as one day of source separated organics collection per week

if the commercial establishment is a designated covered establishment.

However, there are businesses that generate a large amount of waste such that they currently require waste collection as frequently as five days per week. If these businesses were assigned an awardee for waste collection just two days per week, their waste would not be collected in a timely manner and it could build up on the street.

Therefore, the Department proposes to give itself the flexibility to assign a business up to five days a week of waste collection if an assigned business generates an amount of waste that requires collection more frequently than two days a week.

A court reporter is present today and will record the hearing. You may present an oral statement or submit written comments concerning the proposed rule.

We have been accepting written

comments on the proposed rule since it was published. Today is the deadline for submission of written comments.

Such comments may be emailed directly to nycrules@dsny.nyc.gov by 5 p.m. today.

DSNY will make available a copy of all written comments received through today, together with the hearing transcript, for viewing on its website within the next few weeks.

DSNY will carefully consider all the comments it receives today at the hearing and all written comments it receives.

When you speak, please say your name and affiliation, and speak slowly and clearly so that the court reporter can understand and accurately record your statement. We also ask that you limit your statement to three minutes.

Okay. So, there's nobody who has pre-signed-up, so if anybody wants to speak, just go ahead and drop your name and affiliation in the chat.

Okay. Mr. Toscano, go ahead and introduce yourself, please.

MR. TOSCANO: Good morning. My name is Thomas Toscano. I'm the CEO of Boro-Wide Recycling. We are one of the awardees in Queens central.

My statement is very simple. I agree with the rule as written and we have approximately now 200 customers that have been assigned to us that currently have more than the two days a week MSW and one day a week recycling on the assignment.

To take customers off routes for the

1	extra days and put them back on causes
2	issues not only for the customer, but
3	for the drivers. It results in more
4	missed pick-ups with changing routes
5	that they used to.
6	The rule makes a lot of sense and
7	the sooner it can be passed the better.
8	That's all I have.
9	MS. LIPMAN: Thank you.
