Automotive Products

(antifreeze, motor oil, transmission fluid, batteries, gasoline)



Household Products

(cleaners, pesticides, paint, compact fluorescent light bulbs, flammable gas, fire extinguishers, rechargeable batteries, thermostats, e-cigarettes)



Medical Items

(medications, syringes, needles, scalpels, lancets)



Electronics

(computers and accessories, TVs and video equipment, cell phones, tablets, e-readers, video game consoles)

How to Safely Package Materials Before Dropping Off



Read item labels carefully before handling. Follow directions for any items labeled **DANGER**, **POISON**, or **CAUTION**.

DO NOT mix products or bring open containers.

To get items ready for transport:

- Label products clearly.
- Seal containers tightly.
- Place syringes and lancets in leak-proof, puncture-resistant containers (like “sharps” containers).
- Pack leaky items inside larger containers, using absorbent material to soak up excess fluid.
- Put items with broken glass into separate sealed bags or boxes.
