




Trick-or-Treating at Corlears Hook Park



- 4. Micropile installation, fence installation, Con Edison work, and jet grouting. Floodwall operations at Montgomery Street and South Street.







ALL WORK IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Ongoing, temporary closure of sidewalk on south side of Water Street, near 645 Water Street

- Expected closure for 2-3 weeks
- Contractor opened a portion of Water Street to provide accessible pedestrian detour
- Work is necessary to access utilities

Water Street on track to reopen mid-November when sidewalk work is complete, to be followed by Gouverneur Slip E.




